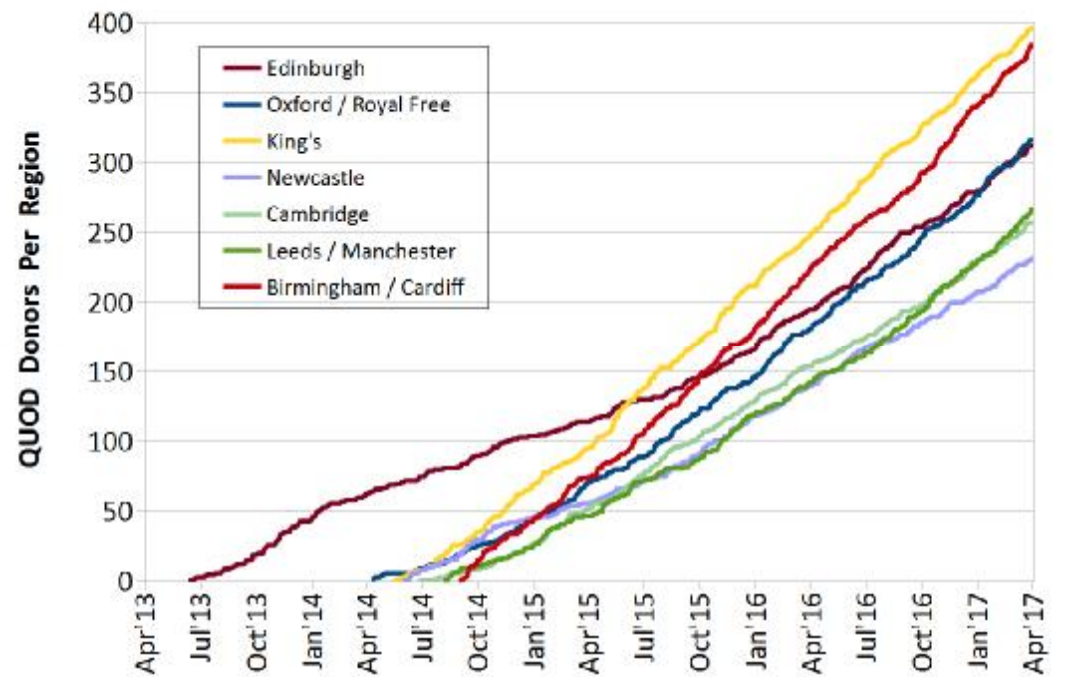

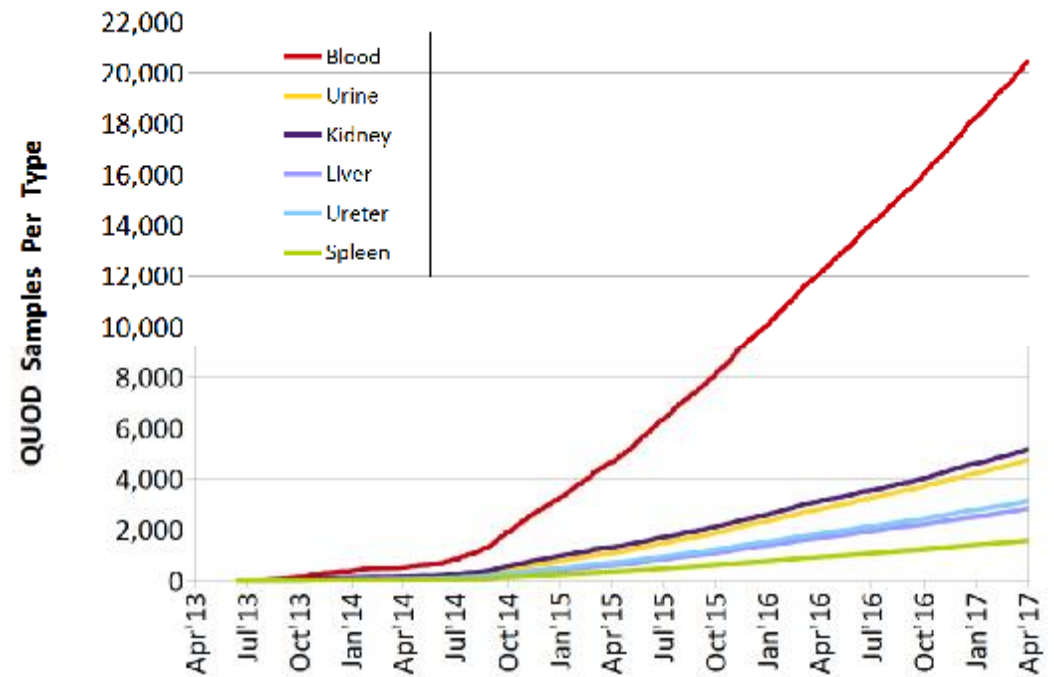
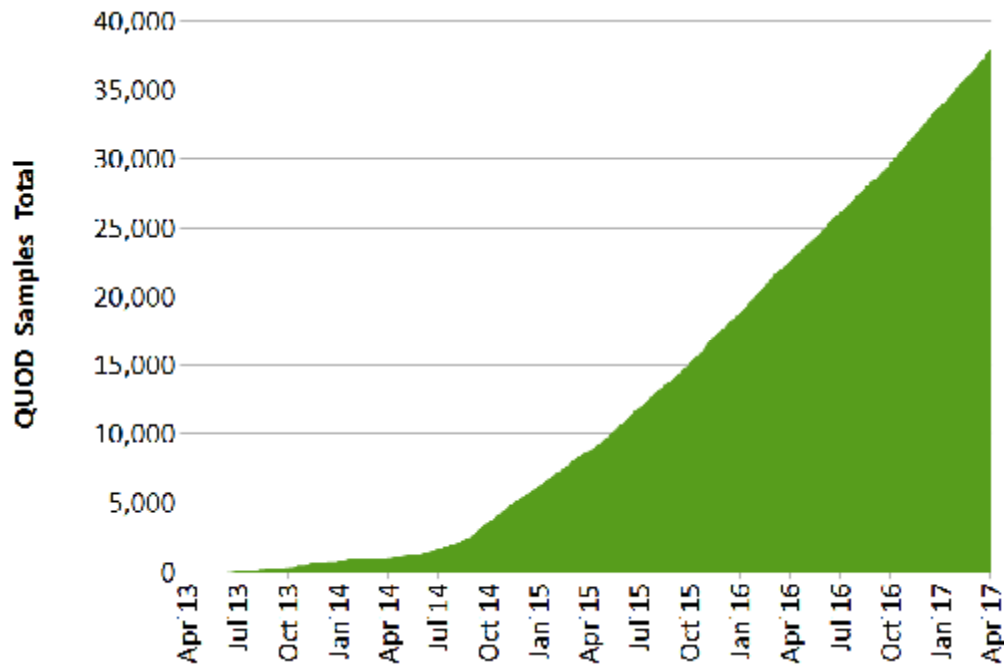


QUOD Donors In Total and Per Region





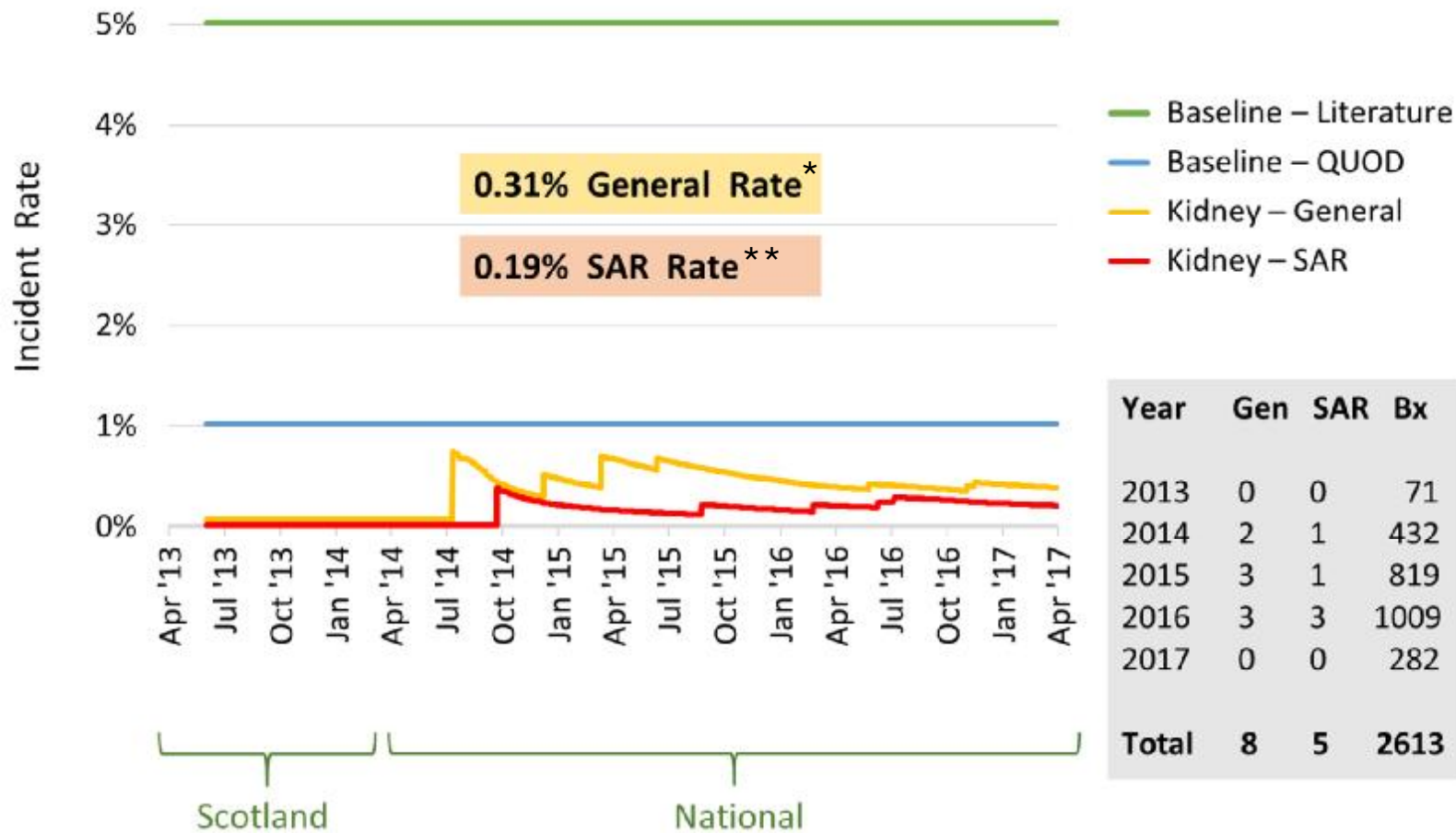
QUOD Samples In Total and Per Type

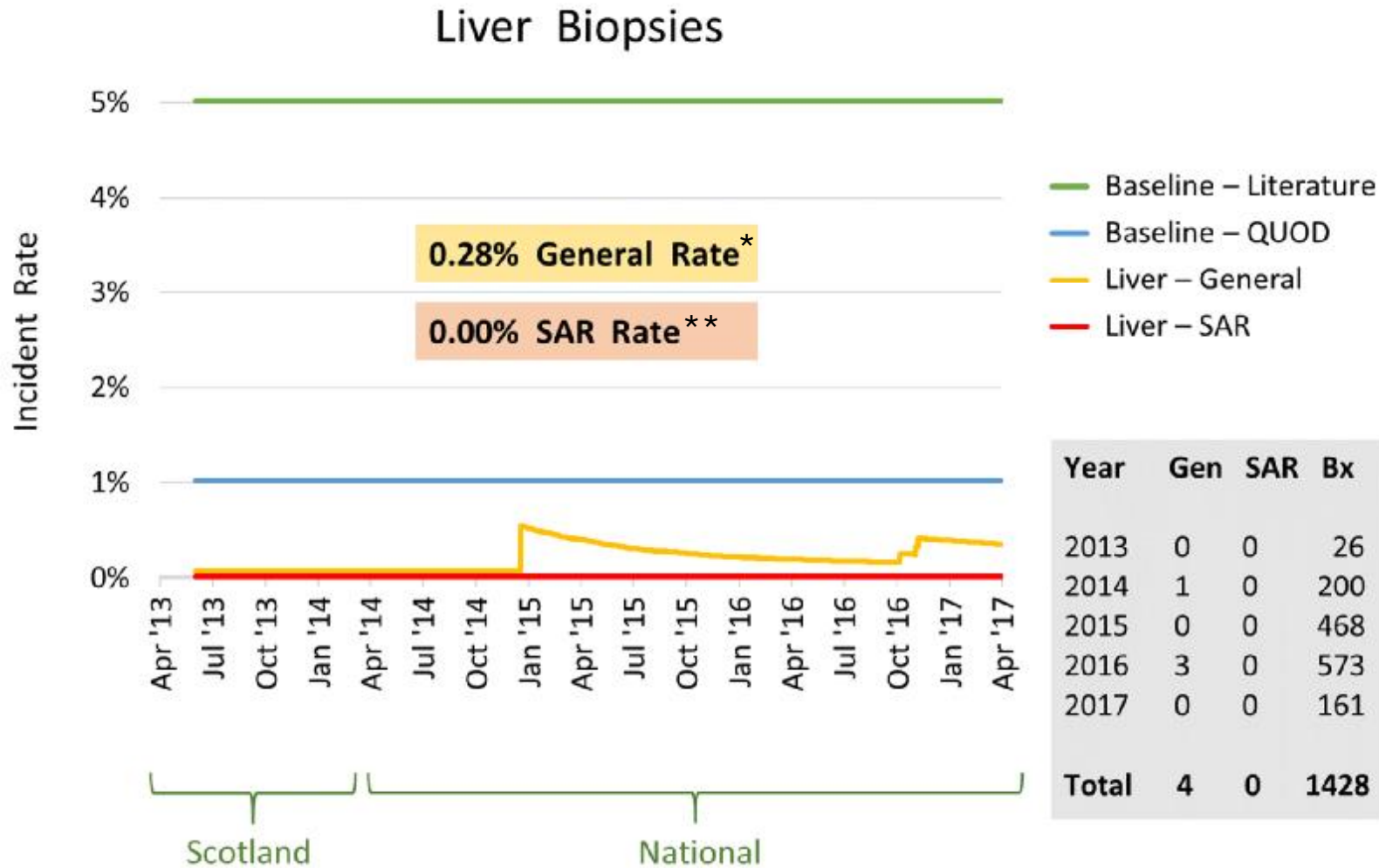
Kidney Biopsies

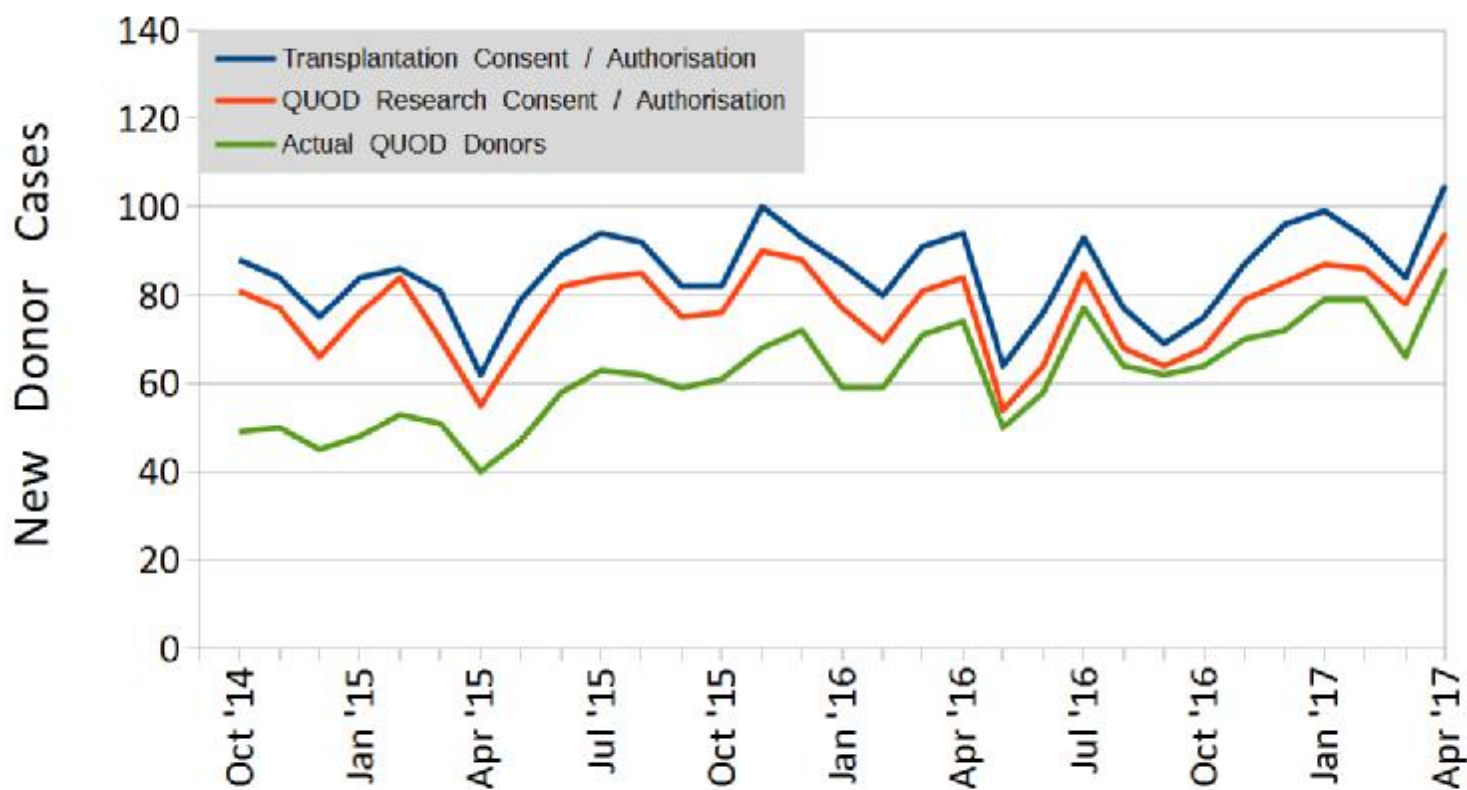

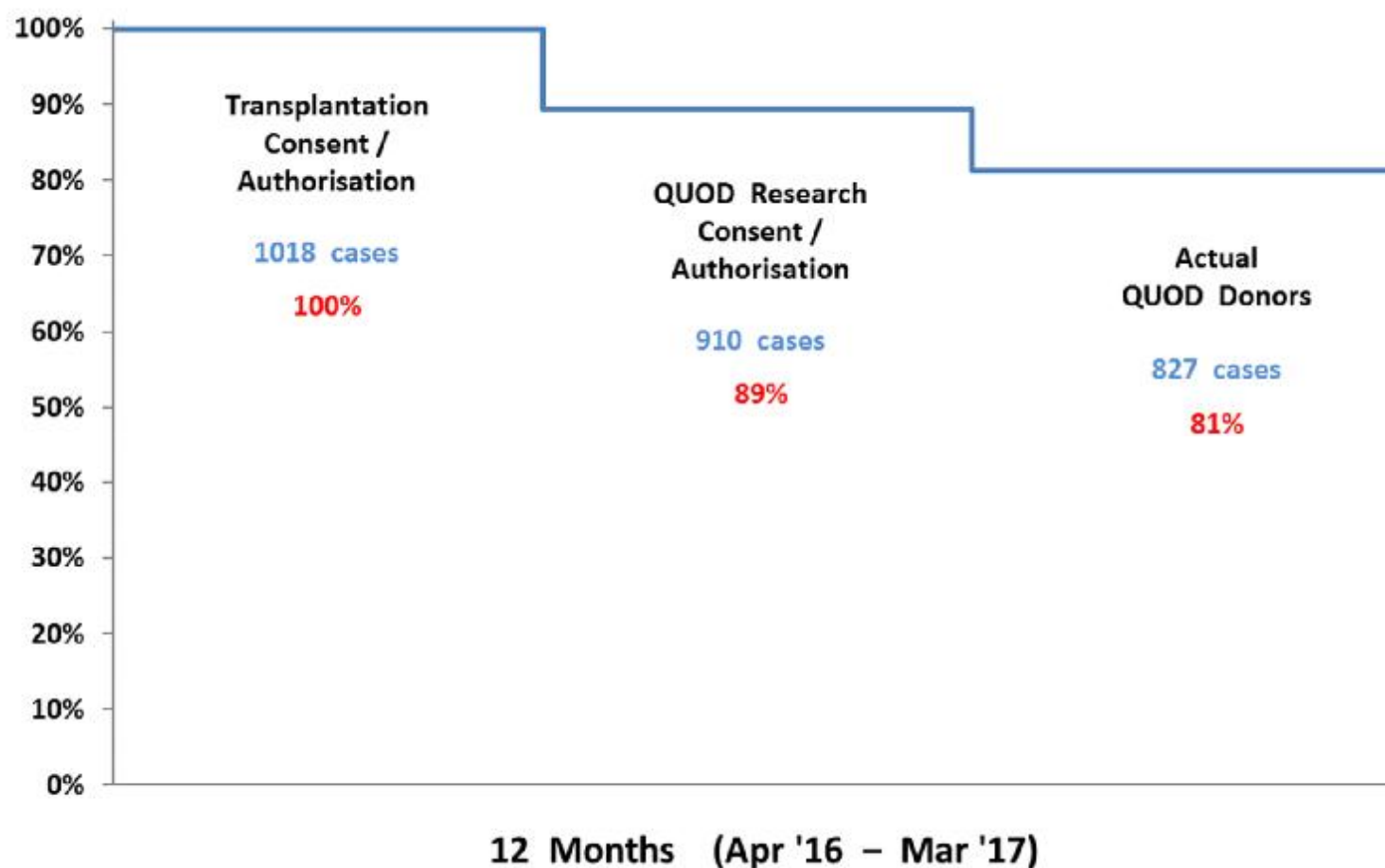
Consent for QUOD Research and Actual QUOD Donors — Per Month



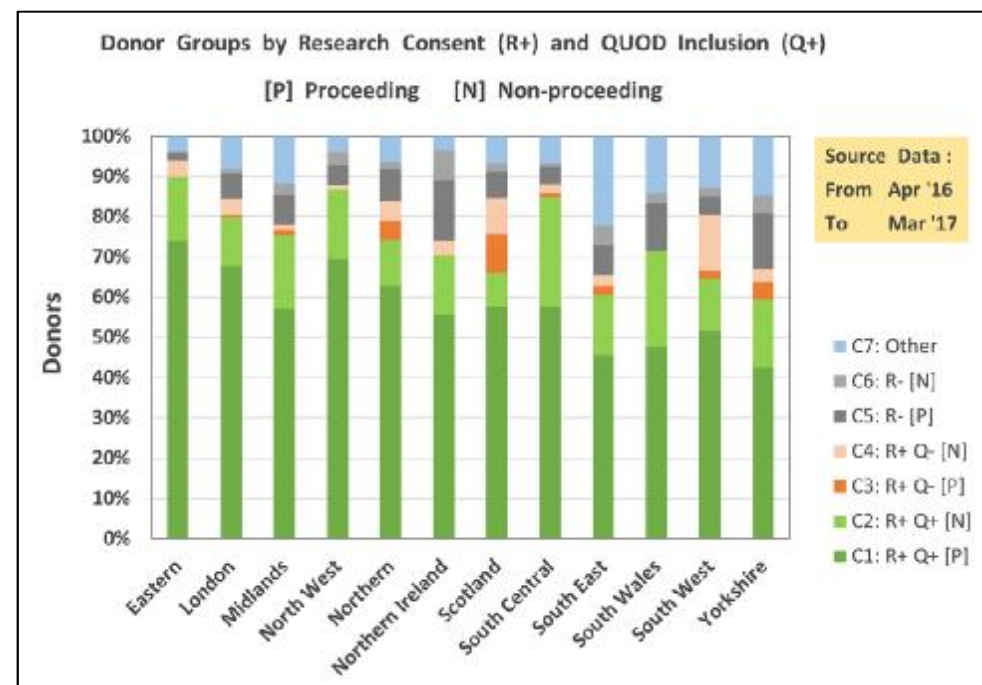
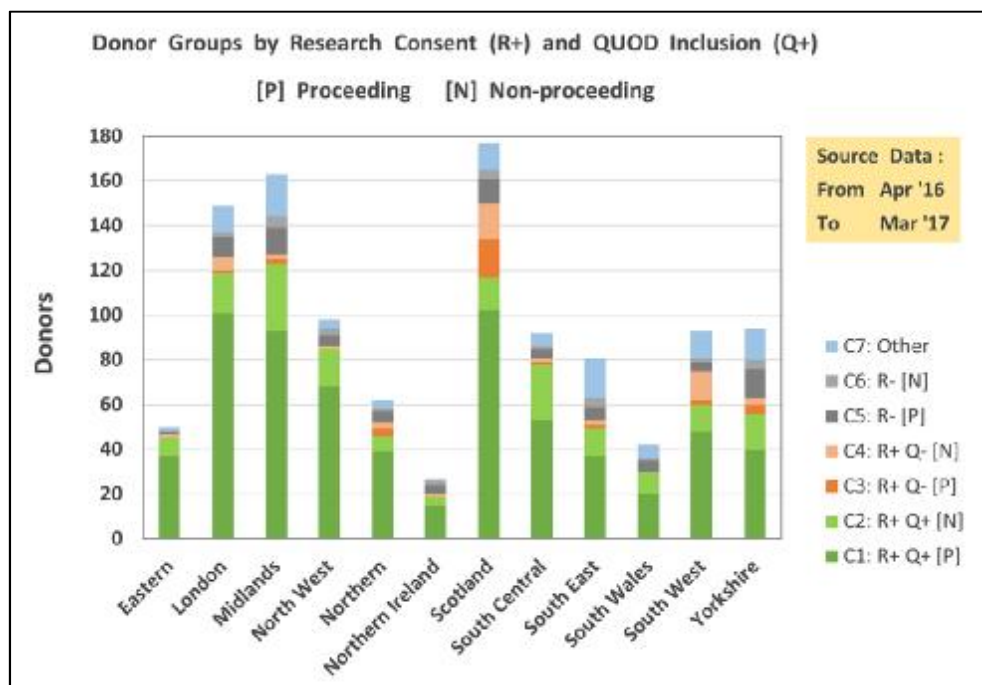

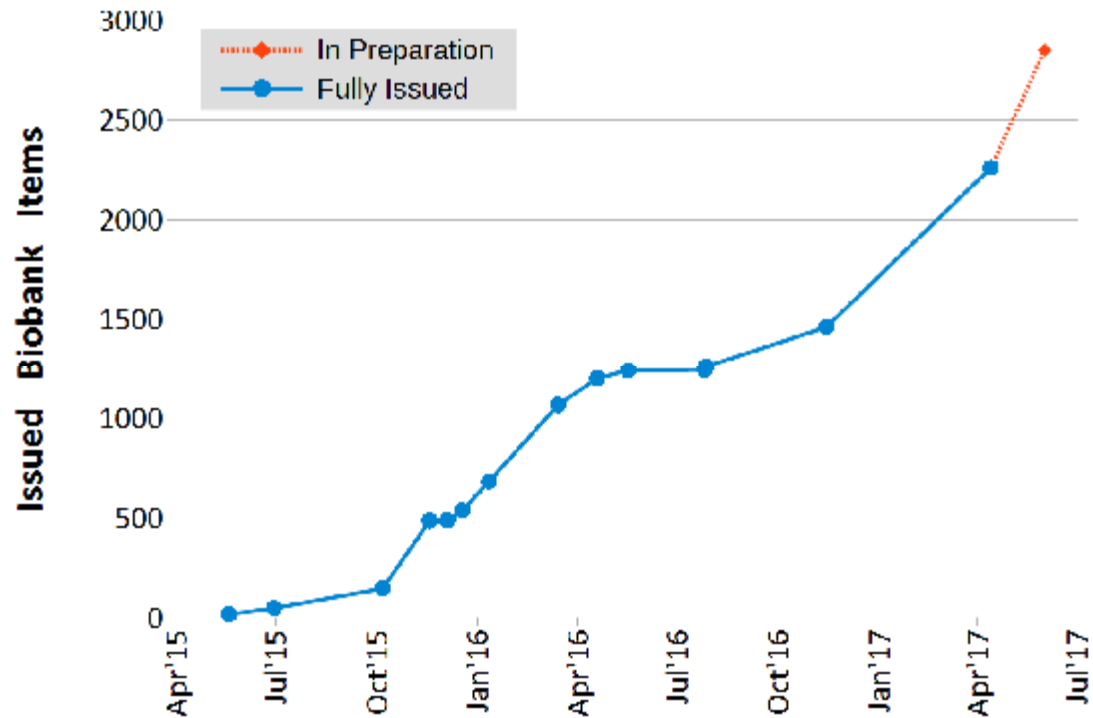
Consent for QUOD Research and Actual QUOD Donors — Step Chart
