- 1 This paper provides an update from Statistics and Clinical Studies and summarises recent presentations, publications, current and future work.

**UPDATE FROM STATISTICS AND CLINICAL STUDIES**

- 2 The Annual Organ Donation and Transplantation Activity Report for 2014/15 has been published with an accompanying slide set that can be found here - <http://www.odt.nhs.uk/uk-transplant-registry/annual-activity-report/>.
- 3 The first Annual Organ Specific Report on Kidney transplantation was published by NHSBT in September 2014 and the second report covering 10 years of kidney transplant data to 31 March 2015 is now available. It presents information on patients on the transplant list, number of transplants and survival after transplantation on a national and centre-specific basis. **CONFERENCE PRESENTATIONS**

- 5 One oral presentation on 'Annual kidney transplant activity' was given at the Patient Support Group Meeting in July.
- 6 Three oral presentations on 'ECD vs SCD kidneys', 'DCD Kidney Allocation Scheme' and 'Kidney transplant activity' were given at the ESOT conference in September.
- 7 Two oral presentations on the EUROSTAM project and one oral presentation on 'Highly sensitised patients' were given at BSHI in September.

**CURRENT AND FUTURE WORK**

- 8 An interim Report on Kidney Transplantation for 2015/16 is due to be published in December this year.
- 9 Continue to monitor the DCD Regional Sharing Scheme.

- 10 Implement a change to the National Kidney Allocation Scheme to calculate waiting time from start of dialysis.
- 11 Undertake analysis to support the ATTOM project.
- 12 Continue to monitor and develop (as required) the Living Donor Sharing Schemes and the 2006 National DBD Kidney Allocation Scheme
- 13 Undertake analysis to support the three Kidney Allocation Working Groups.

**KIDNEY AND PANCREAS RESEARCH GROUP**

- 14 There have been no further meetings of the Kidney and Pancreas Research Group (KPRG). Applications for data have been considered via email discussion.
- 15 The Research Group support and encourage publication of analyses undertaken either as part of core work or in support of external collaborators.

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
