

London Organ Donation Services Team

Taking Organ Transplantation to 2020

In 2018/19, from 271 consented donors the London Organ Donation Services Team facilitated 197 actual solid organ donors resulting in 522 patients receiving a life-saving or life-changing transplant. Data obtained from the UK Transplant Registry.

In addition to the 197 proceeding donors there were 74 consented donors that did not proceed.




Referral of potential deceased organ donors

Goal: Every patient who meets the referral criteria should be identified and referred to NHS Blood and Transplant's Organ Donation Service

Aim: There should be no purple on the chart







776 potential organ donors were referred to the team during 2018/19. There were 47 occasions where potential organ donors were not referred.

When compared with UK performance, the performance within the Trusts in the team was average (bronze) for referral of potential organ donors to NHS Blood and Transplant.




Presence of Specialist Nurse for Organ Donation

Goal: A Specialist Nurse for Organ Donation (SNOD) should be present during every organ donation discussion with families

Aim: There should be no purple on the chart

Aim: The team (marked with a cross) should fall within Bronze, Silver, or Gold



A SNOD was present for 399 organ donation discussions with families during 2018/19. There were 31 occasions where a SNOD was not present.

When compared with UK performance, the performance within the Trusts in the team was average (bronze) for SNOD presence when approaching families to discuss organ donation.
