Advice following Department for Health and Social Care (DHSC) announcement on the treatment of patients with Thrombotic Thrombocytopenic Purpura (TTP)

Following this <u>announcement</u> our advice is clinicians should continue to follow <u>BSH</u> <u>guidelines for the treatment of TTP</u> which advocates the use of solvent detergent plasma (SD-FFP) for this patient group.

I would like to thank hospital colleagues for completing our survey capturing their initial response to the announcement. Nearly 50% of hospitals, currently being brought into our planning assumptions for the transition to UK plasma self-sufficiency responded to the survey.
