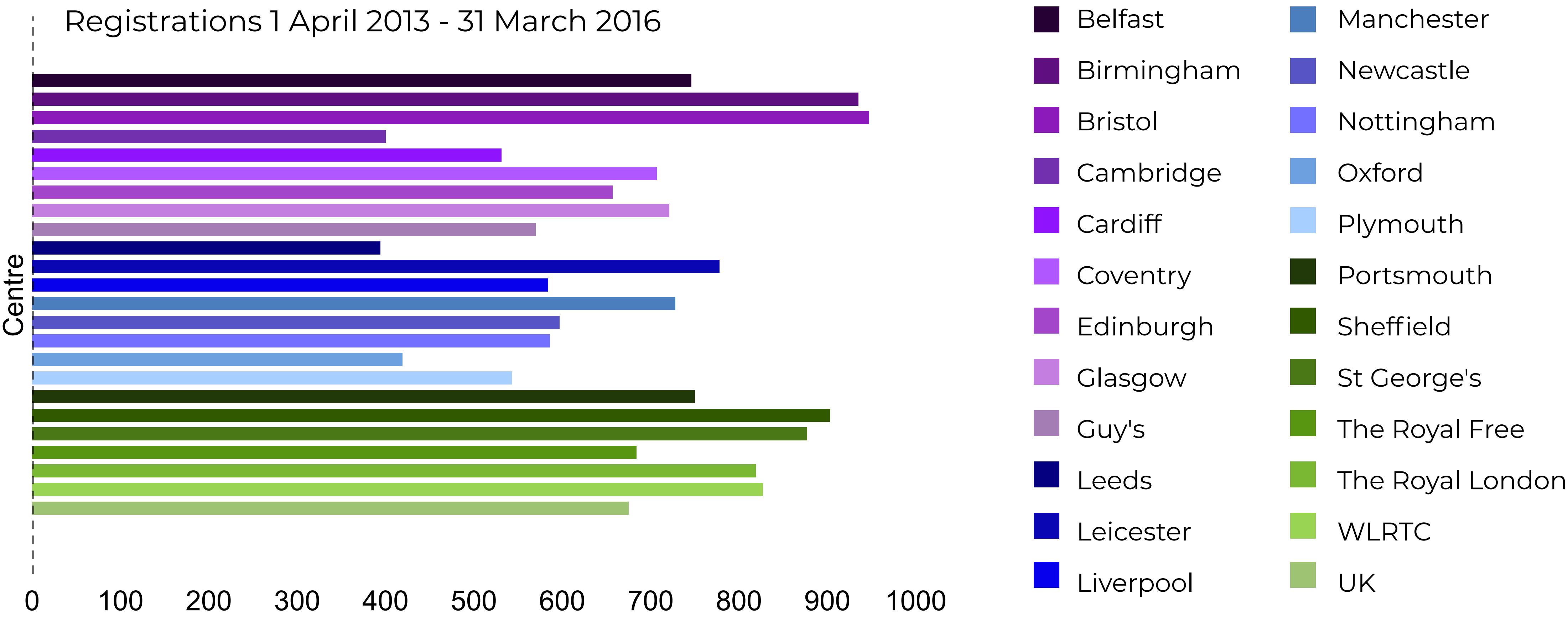




ADULT KIDNEY TRANSPLANTS FROM DECEASED DONORS



How long do people wait for a kidney transplant?

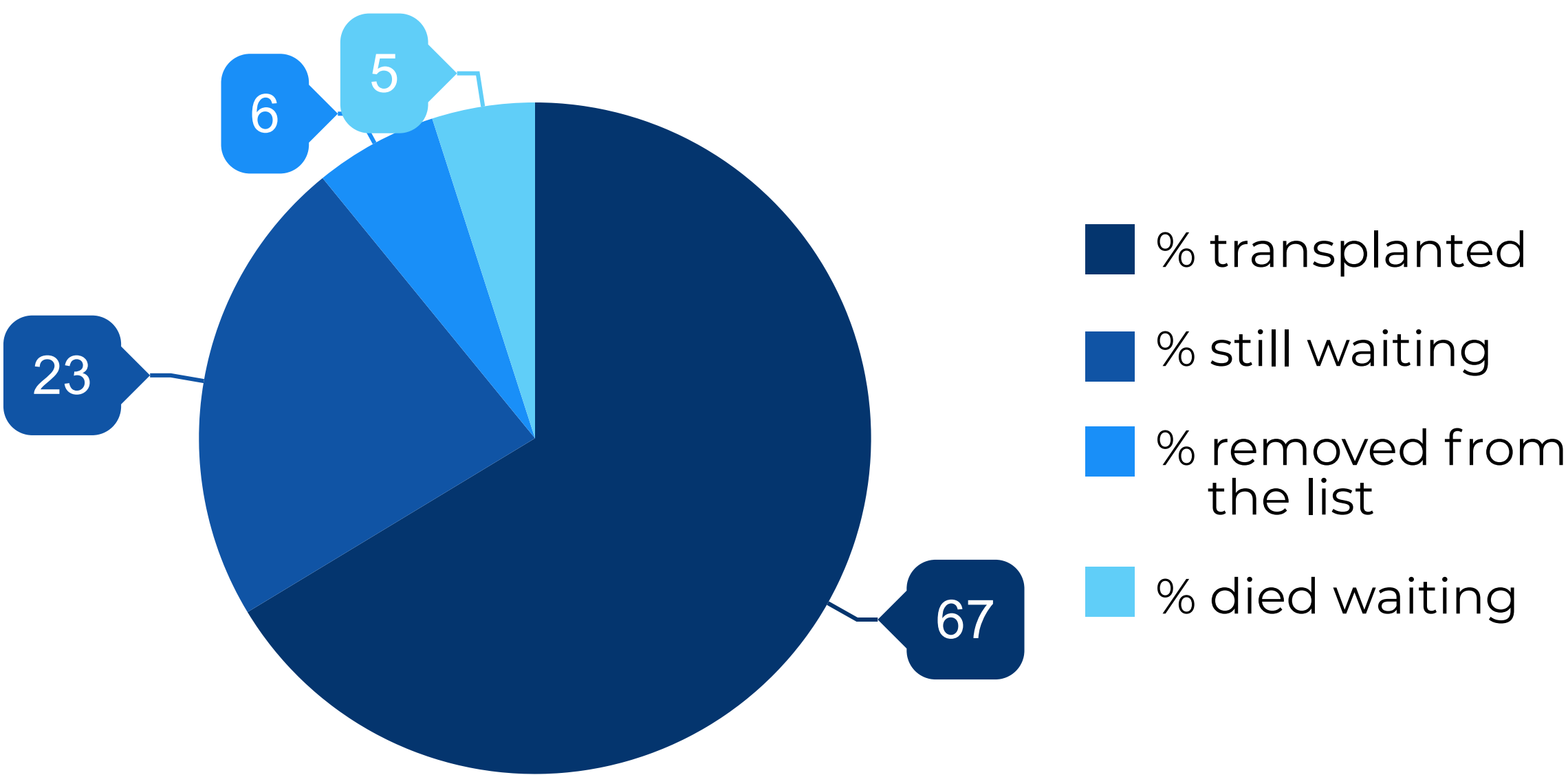


Days waiting (median)

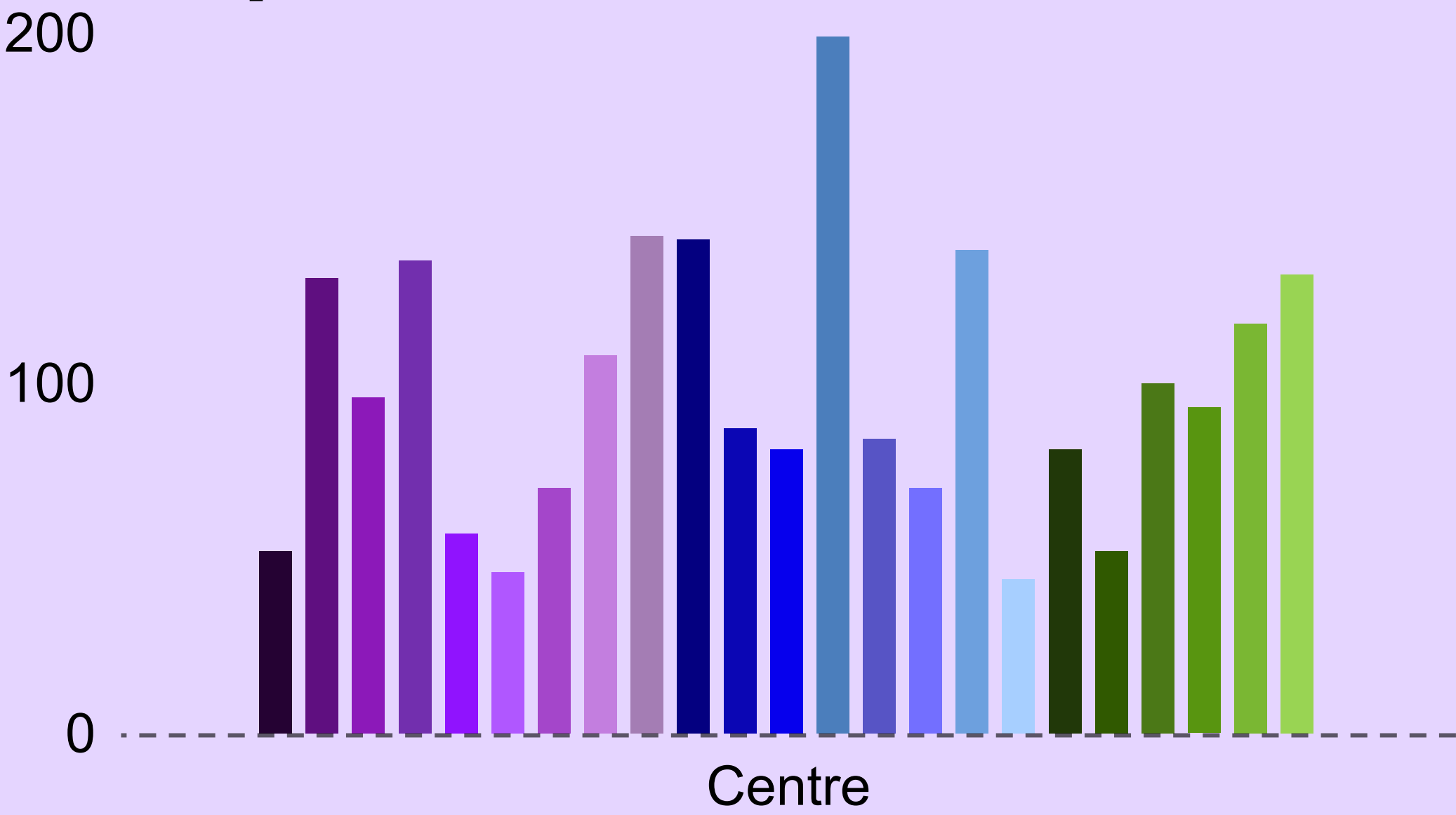
The median is a type of average and is the time when half of patients have received a transplant

Lots of things affect how long you might wait, including your blood group and HLA type

Nationally, 3 years after going on the list

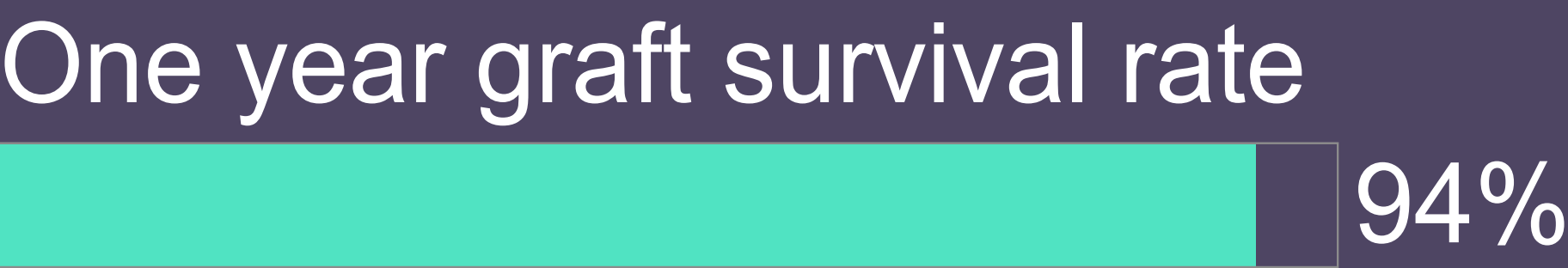


Average number of transplants per year between 1 April 2016 - 31 March 2019



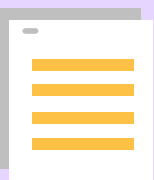
What are the chances of my kidney surviving for one year after transplant?

On average, 94 out of 100 kidneys are still functioning after one year following a deceased donor kidney transplant



What are the chances of a person surviving for one year after transplant?

On average, 97 out of 100 adult patients are alive after one year following a deceased donor kidney transplant
