

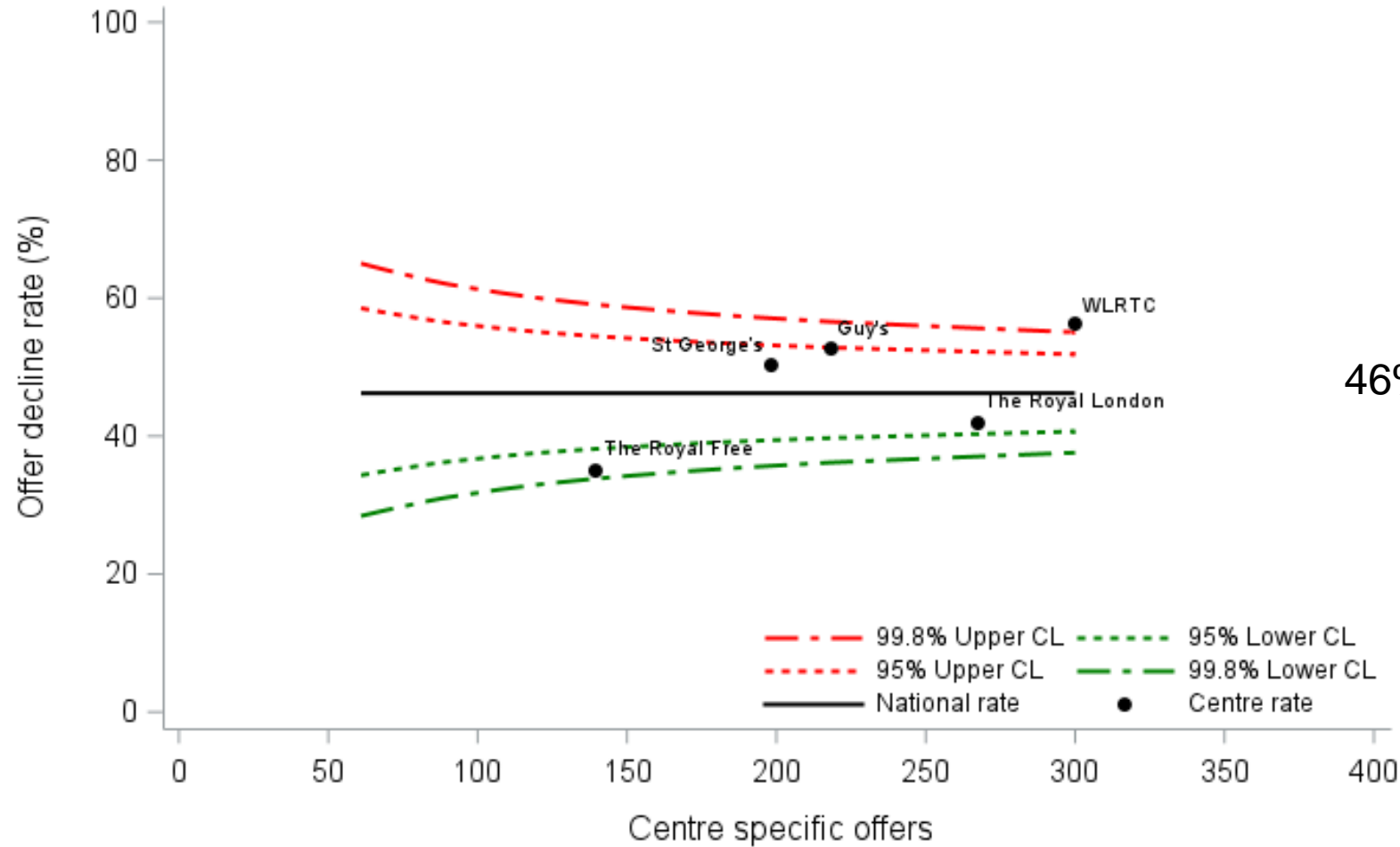

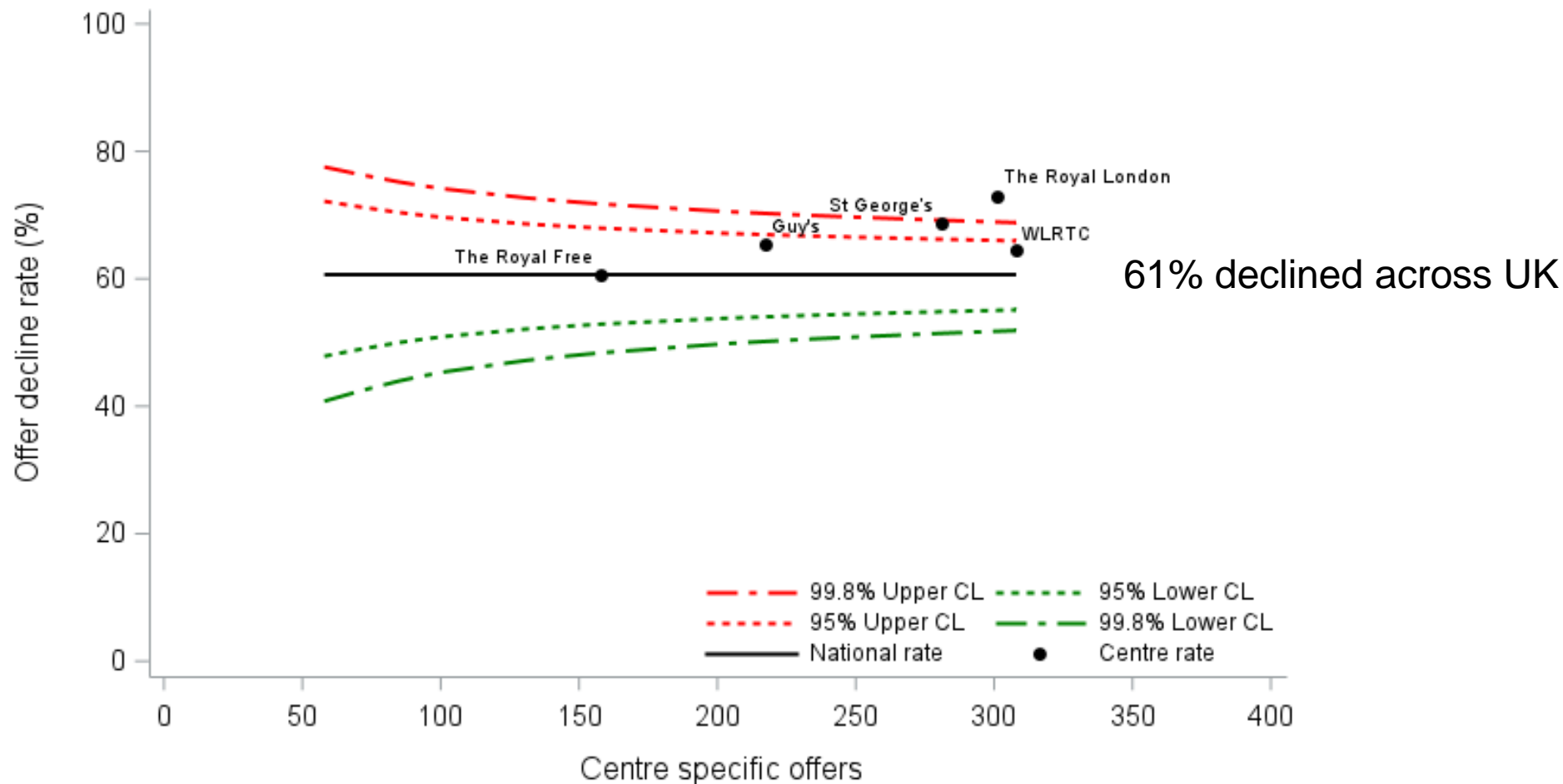
# Offer Declines DBD Standard Criteria



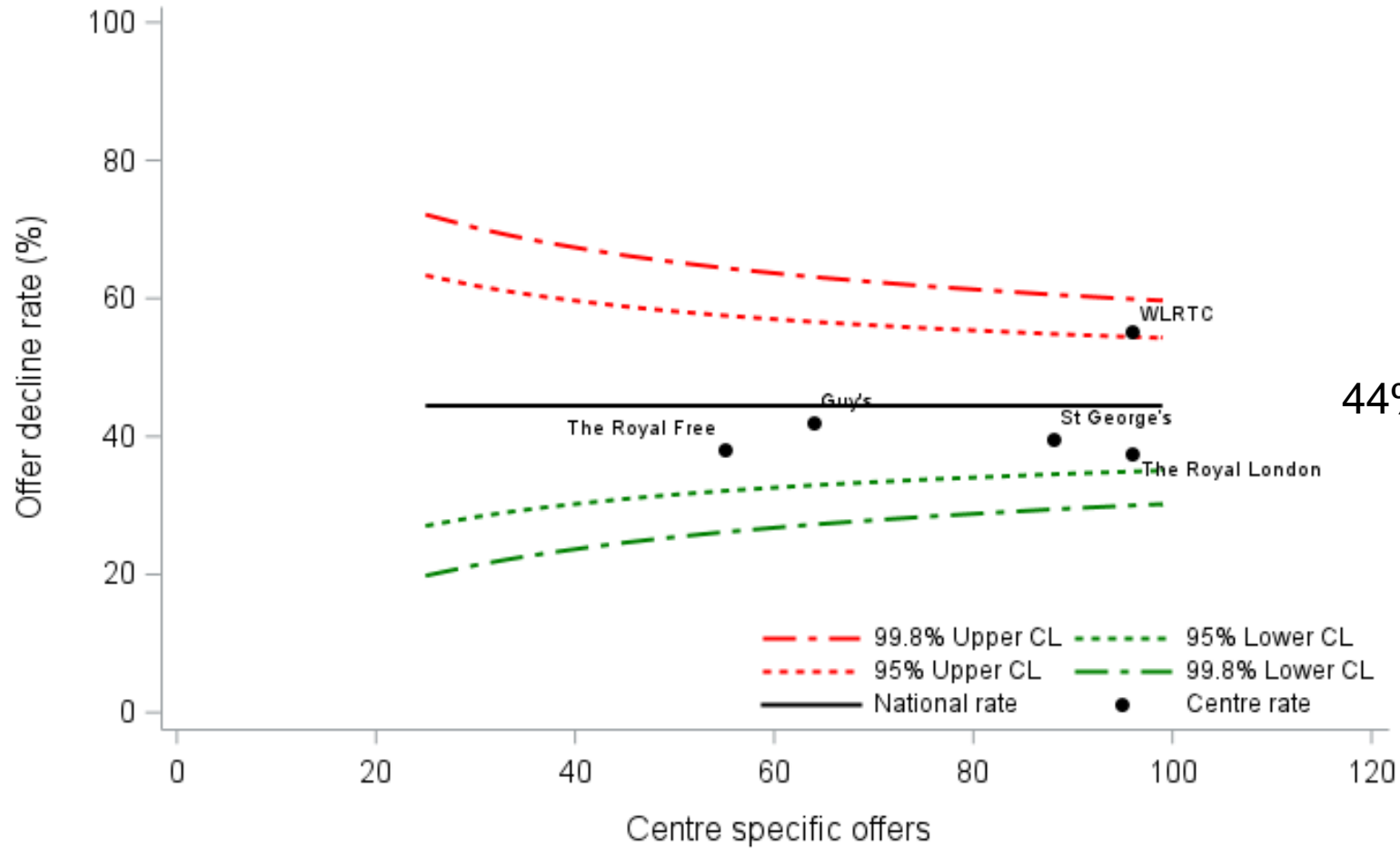
46% declined across UK

# Offer Declines DBD Extended Criteria



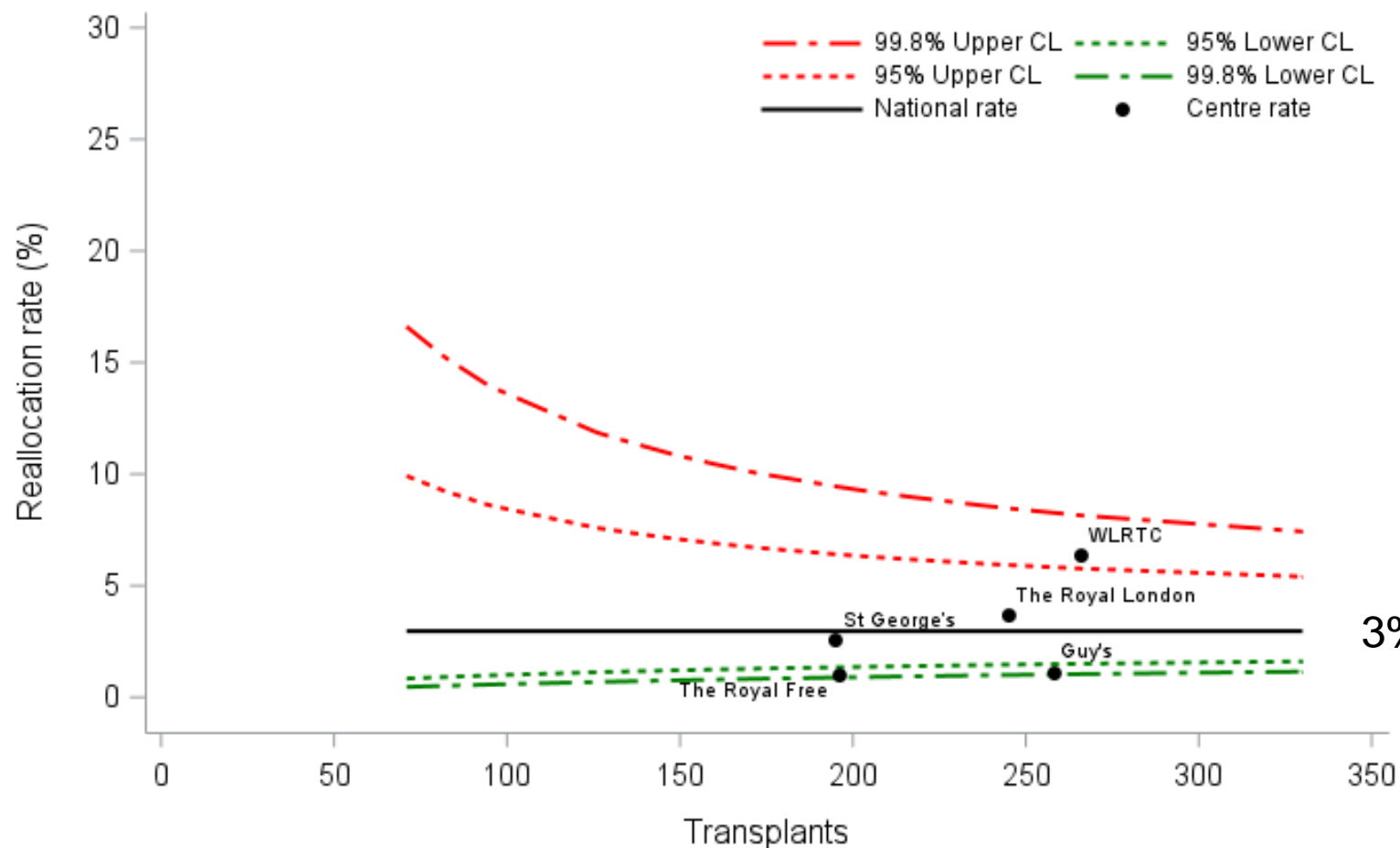
# Offer Declines DCD Standard Criteria

# Introduction – London Kidney Offers

- Data provided on offers between August 2018 and July 2019 where the kidney was declined by one London centre and used by another
- 341 cases in total
- 27 kidneys not transplanted
- 8 graft failures within 90 days
  - 3 were ‘accepted by centre, not used and transplanted elsewhere’
  - 5 were ‘declined by centre, transplanted elsewhere’

# Offer Method Summary

- Kidney only offers to London centres from 1 August 2018 to 31 July 2019

# Primary reasons for decline – all centres

	<b>N</b>	<b>%</b>
Donor unsuitable – past history	68	20
Recipient unfit	43	13
Donor unsuitable - age	38	11
Other	36	11
Recipient did not need transplant	35	10
Recipient refused	30	9
Poor function	17	5
Recipient unavailable	15	4
Anatomical	11	3



# Summary

- Overall decline rate of 46% for DBD SCD kidneys across UK, 44% for DCD
- There were 341 kidneys declined by London centres, where the kidneys went on to be transplanted at another London centre between August 2018 and July 2019
- Most common reason for decline over this period was 'Donor Unsuitable – past history'
