

2018/19 ORGAN DONATION AND TRANSPLANTATION

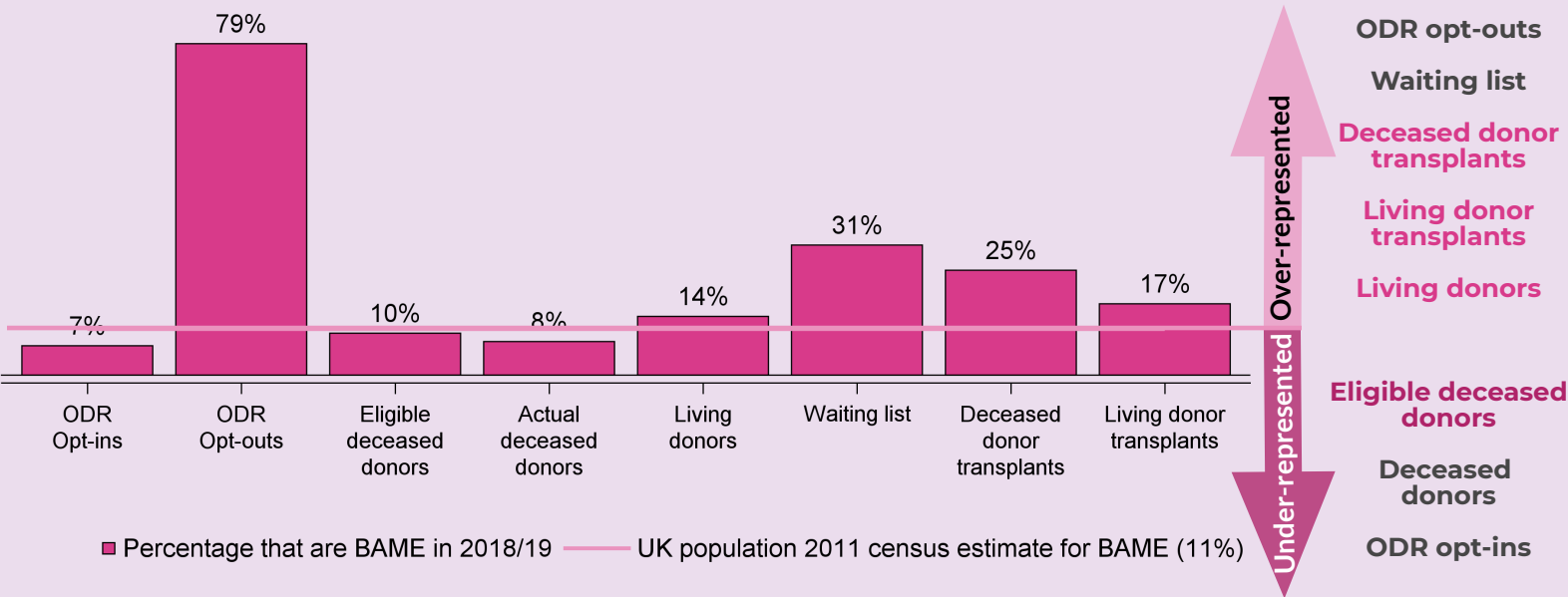
FOR BLACK, ASIAN AND MINORITY ETHNIC (BAME) COMMUNITIES

1% of people who die each year, die in circumstances suitable for organ donation

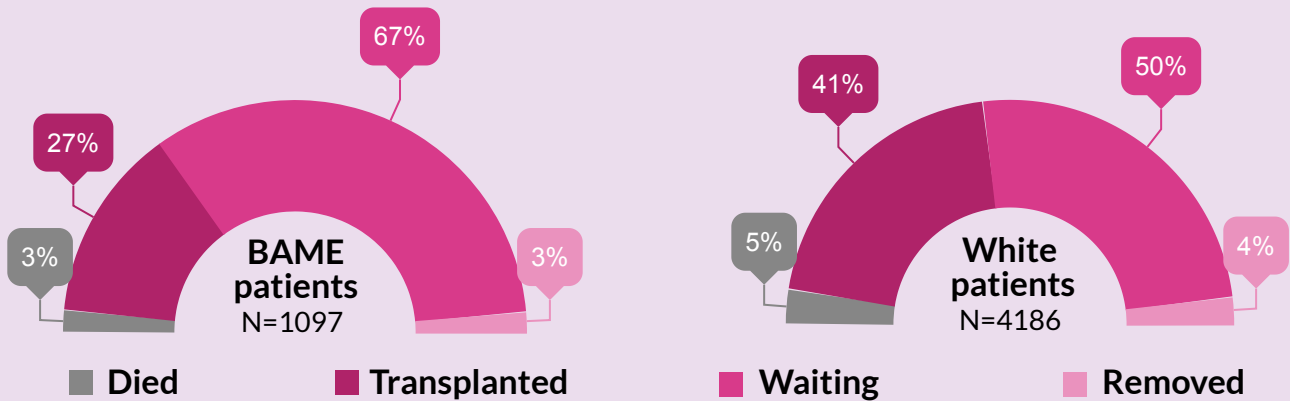
10% of all eligible deceased donors are from BAME communities

Family consent rates for organ donation are 42% for BAME and 71% for white eligible donors

Percentage that are BAME relative to the UK population



Outcomes after one year of being listed for transplantation



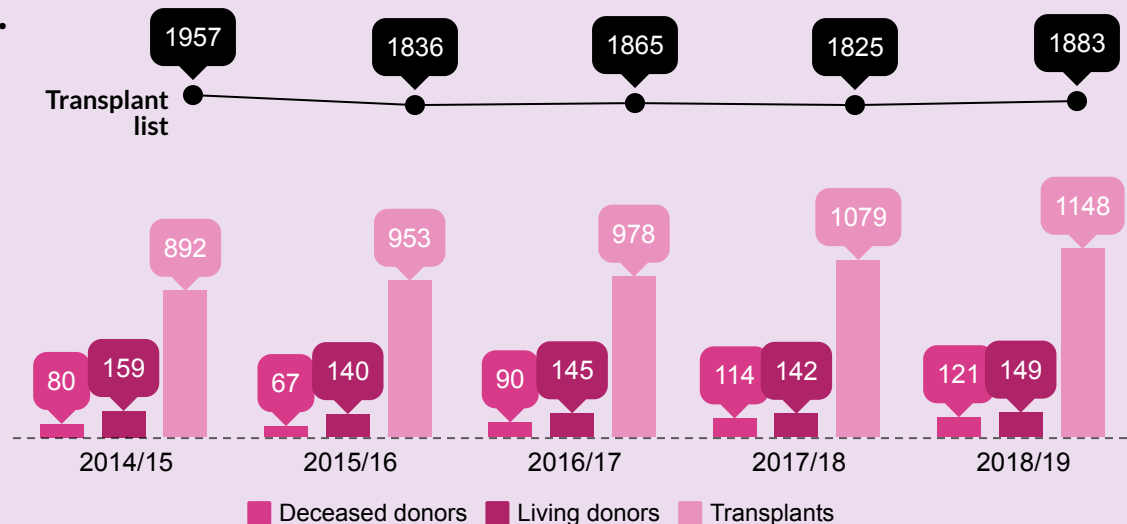
Over the last 5 years...

4% fall in BAME patients waiting on the list

29% increase in transplants for BAME patients (all organs)

6% fall in BAME living donors

51% increase in BAME deceased organ donors
