Total number of patients randomised:

408

50% of all patients randomised will receive convalescent plasma, and each patient will receive 2 units.

Leicester Hospitals – 24 patients

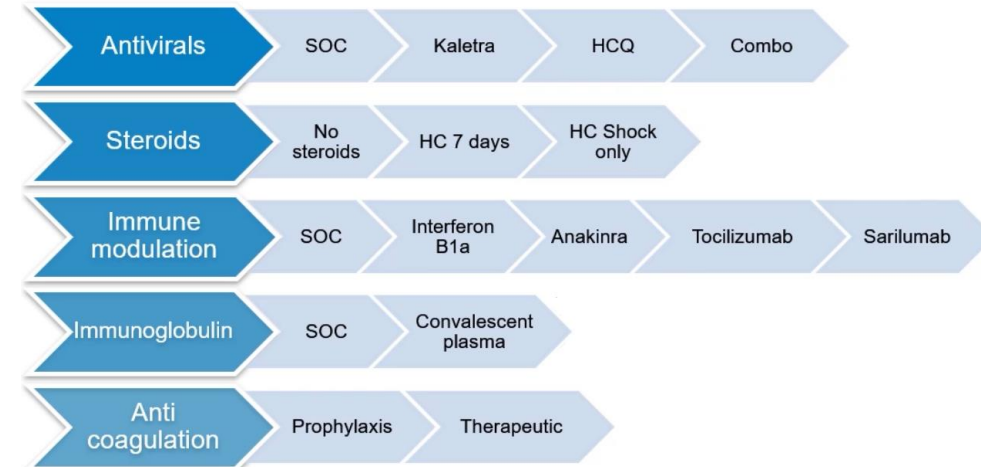
Which Trust has randomised the highest number of patients into the RECOVERY trial?



North West Anglia – 29 patients

The REMAP-CAP trial is formed of multiple 'domains', allowing each patient to be randomly allocated to multiple treatments.

Convalescent plasma is part of the **Immunoglobulin** domain:

- SARS-CoV-2 infection (clinically suspected or laboratory confirmed)
- No medical history that might put the patient at significant risk if he/she were to participate in the trial

SUMMARY OF TRIAL INCLUSION CRITERIA

- Adults admitted to an Intensive Care Unit
- SARS-CoV-2 infection (laboratory confirmed)
- No medical history that might put the patient at significant risk if he/she were to participate in the trial
