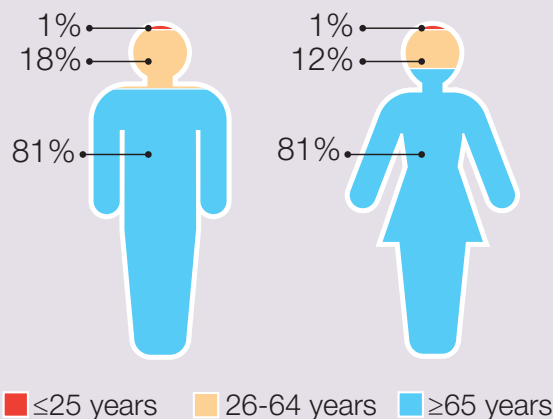
Deceased Organ Donors UK, 2019

301,579 males 303,128 females

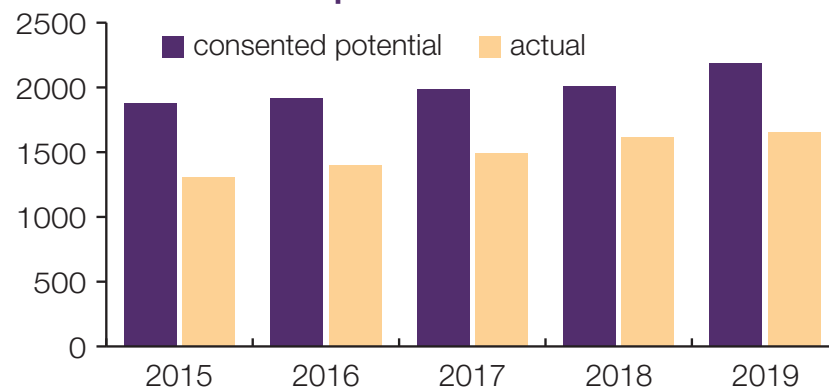


2196 consented potential deceased donors where family have given consent to donation (**0.4% of all deaths**)

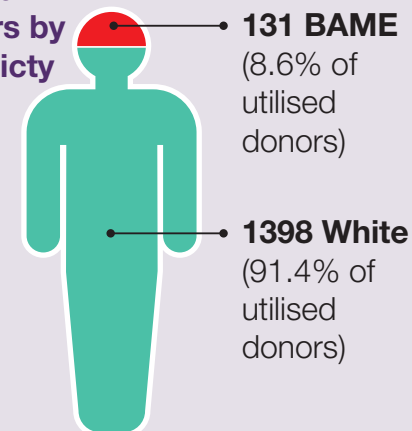
1653 actual donors where at least one organ was retrieved for the purpose of transplantation (**75% of consented potential donors**)

1529 utilised donors where at least one organ was retrieved and transplanted (**92% of actual donors**)

Number of consented potential donors and those who proceed to actual donors

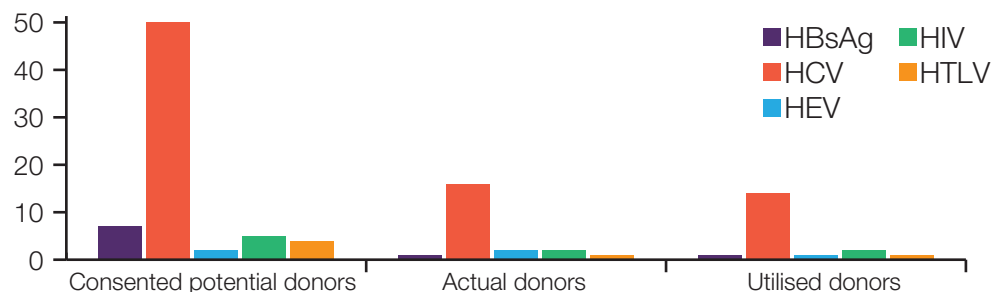


Organ donors by ethnicity
