

2020/21 ORGAN DONATION AND TRANSPLANTATION

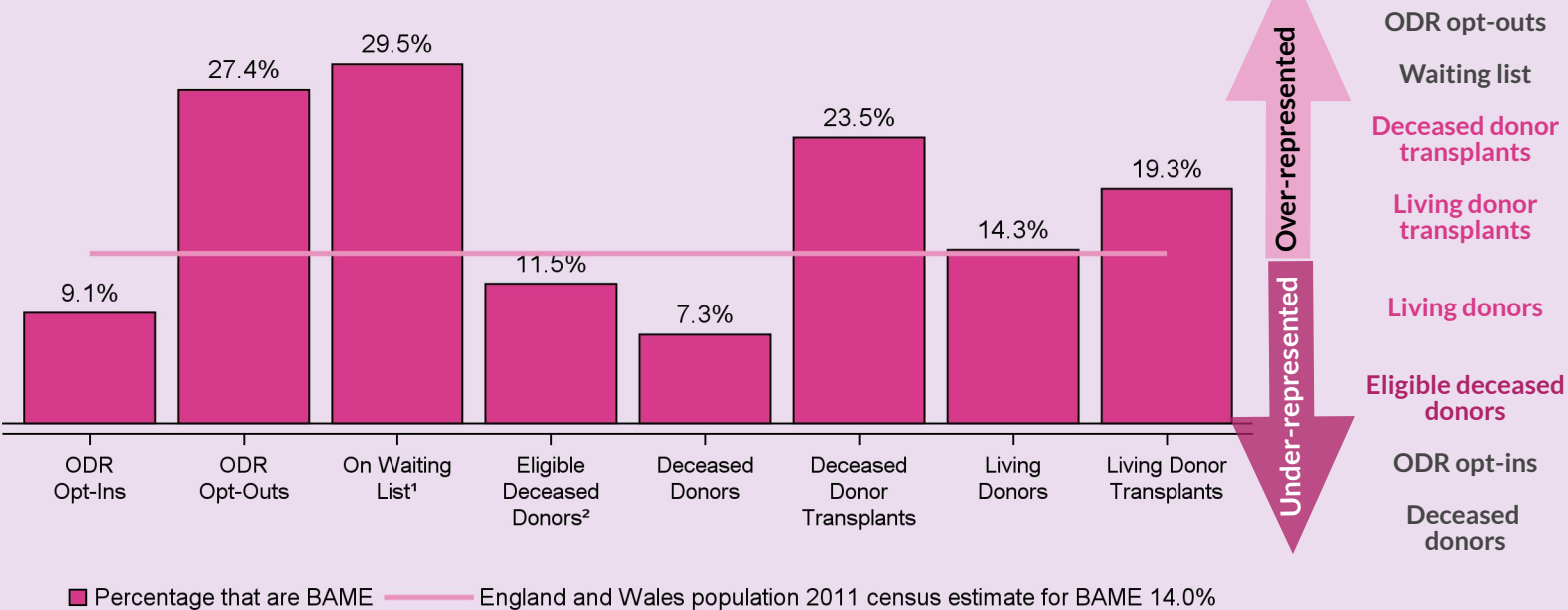
FOR BLACK, ASIAN, MIXED RACE AND MINORITY ETHNIC (BAME) COMMUNITIES

1% of people who die each year, die in circumstances suitable for organ donation

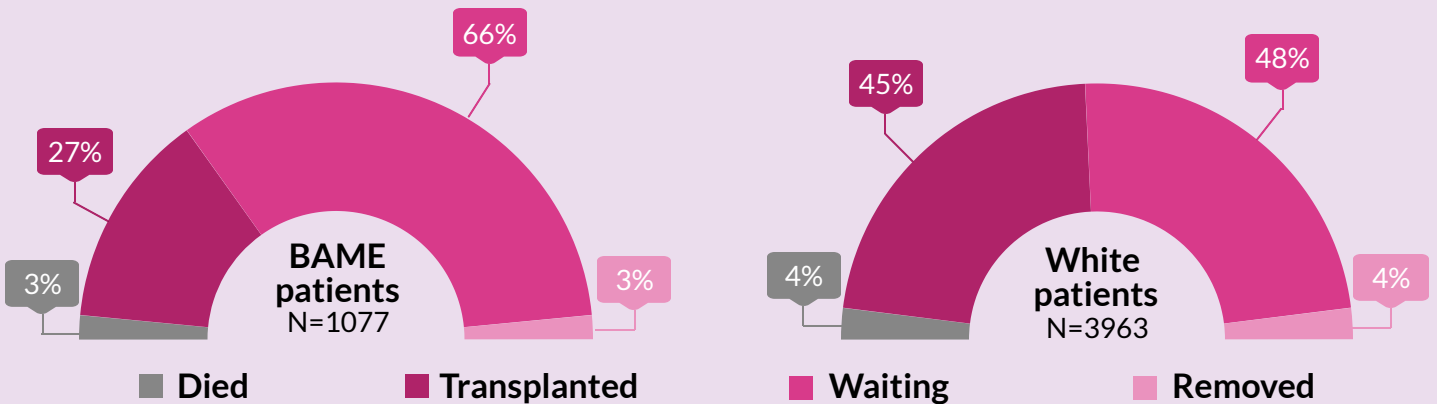
11.5% of all eligible deceased donors are from BAME communities

Family consent rates for organ donation are 36% for BAME and 75% for white eligible donors

Percentage that are BAME relative to the population



Outcome after one year of being listed for transplantation



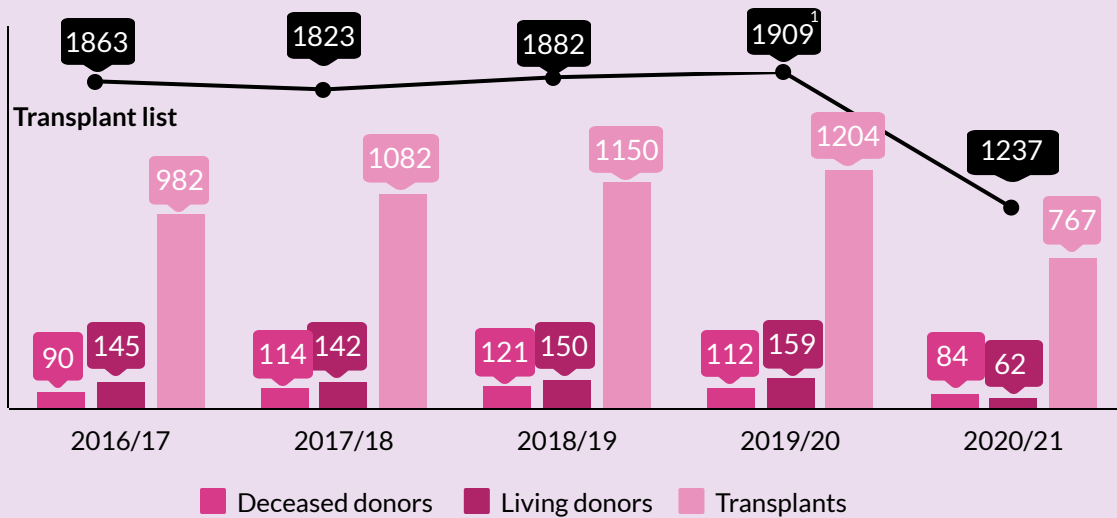
Over the last 5 years...

34% fall in BAME patients waiting on the list due to COVID-19

22% fall in transplants for BAME patients due to COVID-19 (all organs)

57% fall in BAME living donors due to COVID-19

7% fall in BAME deceased organ donors due to COVID-19
