




Pre transplant

- Donor correspondence introduction via OP posters/social media/NHSBT website
- · Social media guidance leaflet at point of listing

Peri transplant

• Reiterating social media guidance when calling patients in for potential transplant

Post transplant

- Donor correspondence explanation of process pre discharge
- Writing to your donor family leaftlet
- Examples of wording for email/letters
- Donor details (if requested)

Follow up

- Dedicated team for Recipient/donor correspondence
- Records of all correspondence
- Quarterly reports of correspondence recieved by the DFCS available from NHSBT

Who is it for?



- Recipients of anonymous living donor transplants
 - From non-directed altruistic living donors
 - Through the UK Living Kidney Sharing Scheme
- Multi-professional transplant teams
 - Write to a living donor on behalf of the team
 - Know the lines of communication- everything goes through the living donor coordinators

Why?



Key points

- Communication is not expected, but is appreciated by living donors
- . We understand that there are many reasons why some transplant recipients feel unable to write
- Your donor will be able to choose when to open your correspondence, at a time that is right for them
- . It's never too early or late to write




4x daisy chain cards for coordinators to send to living donors depending on the relationship to the recipient


