#### Recruitment

A big thank you to the Specialist Nurses for Organ Donation. We currently have **112 Donors** whose family's have kindly agreed for them to take part in the study.

With the fantastic work that the SNODs do our consent rate is currently >80%!



# Trusts/Boards open to recruitment:

### **Monitoring**

We have started to have monitoring calls with site teams - these are informal calls to see how everything is going, to get feedback and to see if there is anything that the SIGNET team can help with.

We aim to have this call a few months after you've recruited your first donor, this is so that we can make sure everything is running smoothly.

So far feedback has been really positive but below are some points to think about:



If the Source Data Form hasn't been left on site, get in touch!



If you're not sure who your donors are the SNODs or CLODs should be able to help - think about a local process to make sure you can get this information



The PI will need to sign off the End of study form for all donors on MACRO



Refresh ICU team training if it's been a while or there are new starters - we are running monthly training sessions



If there are any issues get in touch with us, we may be able to help/offer suggestions, and other sites may have the same problems



Make sure both sides of the Source Data Form are completed



Consider local issues that may affect timings of giving the simvastatin



If you have 'empty' donor slots on MACRO, please use these on your next randomised donors
