



## How long do people wait for a heart transplant?




Registrations 1 April 2015 - 31 March 2018



#### Estimated time from urgent registration to transplant by centre





#### National waiting time by blood group






The median is a type of average and is the time when half of patients have received a transplant

Lots of things affect how long you might wait, including your blood group, presence of antibodies and the availability of the right size organs

On average, **85 out of 100** adult patients are alive after one year following a heart transplant
