Details of Venue: (see also attached map)

CORAM Campus is a 10-minute walk from Kings Cross/St Pancras stations and a 2-minute walk from Russell Square tube station (Piccadilly line)

From Kings Cross station/Euston Road, walk down Judd Street for 500 metres, through 2 sets of traffic lights and then turn left into Brunswick Square. Coram Campus is behind the statue of Thomas Coram at the end of the street.

From Russell Square, turn right as you come out of the tube station onto Bernard Street and walk to the junction with Brunswick Square. You will find Coram in the top corner of the square behind the Thomas Coram statue and next to the Foundling Museum.
