

## NHS Blood and Transplant Review of HTA B return rates Multi-visceral Advisory Group

### Background

There is a statutory obligation to provide information for all organs accepted for the intention of transplantation irrespective of whether that organ was transplanted, sent for research or disposed of. At the end of April 2021, it was identified that there were a significant number of HTA B forms outstanding across the UK. In April 2021, of those forms due in the previous 5 years, there were 510 forms where we do not hold a HTA B at all, and 129 forms received but with information missing or incorrect. Significant work has been undertaken to reduce the volume of missing forms, however currently there are 336 as of 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021.
