- 1 This paper provides an update from Statistics and Clinical Studies and summarises recent presentations, publications and current and future work in the area of pancreas transplantation.

UPDATE FROM STATISTICS AND CLINICAL RESEARCH

- 2 All Advisory Group papers and conference presentations continue to be posted on the ODT Clinical Site www.odt.nhs.uk. The Organ Specific Reports for 2021/2022 have been published, including the report for Pancreas and Islet transplantation. Pancreas and islet transplant outcome sections will be included in an updated version which will be available later this month.

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CONFERENCES

Two abstracts have been submitted for the European Pancreas and Islet Transplantation Association (EPITA) meeting in January 2023:

1. The long-term impact of COVID-19 on pancreas transplantation in the UK
2. Islet isolation and transplantation outcomes from donation after circulatory arrest donors in the UK.

CURRENT AND FUTURE WORK

- 4 An analysis is being undertaken of pancreases offered through the Fast Track Scheme since December 2010 and the outcome of organs transplanted.
- 5 The data collection for the Post Islet Transplant Sensitisation Study has been suspended while a final analysis of all returned data is performed in collaboration with David Turner.
- 6 A paper is being compiled on pancreas transplantation in the UK during the COVID era.
- 7 The DCD working group has met for the first time and initial analysis of data will be starting shortly.
- 8 Work on the 2022/23 Interim Pancreas and Islet Transplantation Organ Specific Report will commence in December.
