- 5 Transplant risk communication tool has been developed and is now available online.
- 6 Work on the annual Renal Unit report is underway and work on the interim report for kidney transplantation will commence shortly.
- 7 An analysis is being undertaken of kidneys offered through the Fast Track Scheme since November 2012 and the outcome of organs transplanted.
- 8 Monitoring of the 2019 National Kidneys Offering Scheme is ongoing and a report on activity in the first 24-months of the scheme circulated as part of this meeting.
