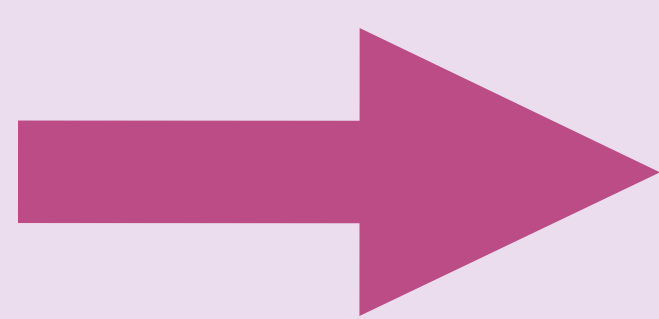


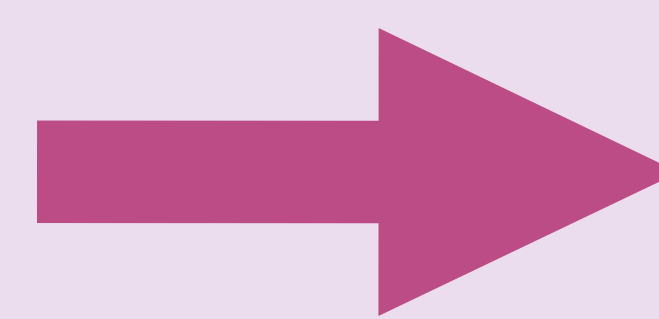
2021/22 ORGAN DONATION AND TRANSPLANTATION

1% of people who die each year, die in circumstances suitable for organ donation

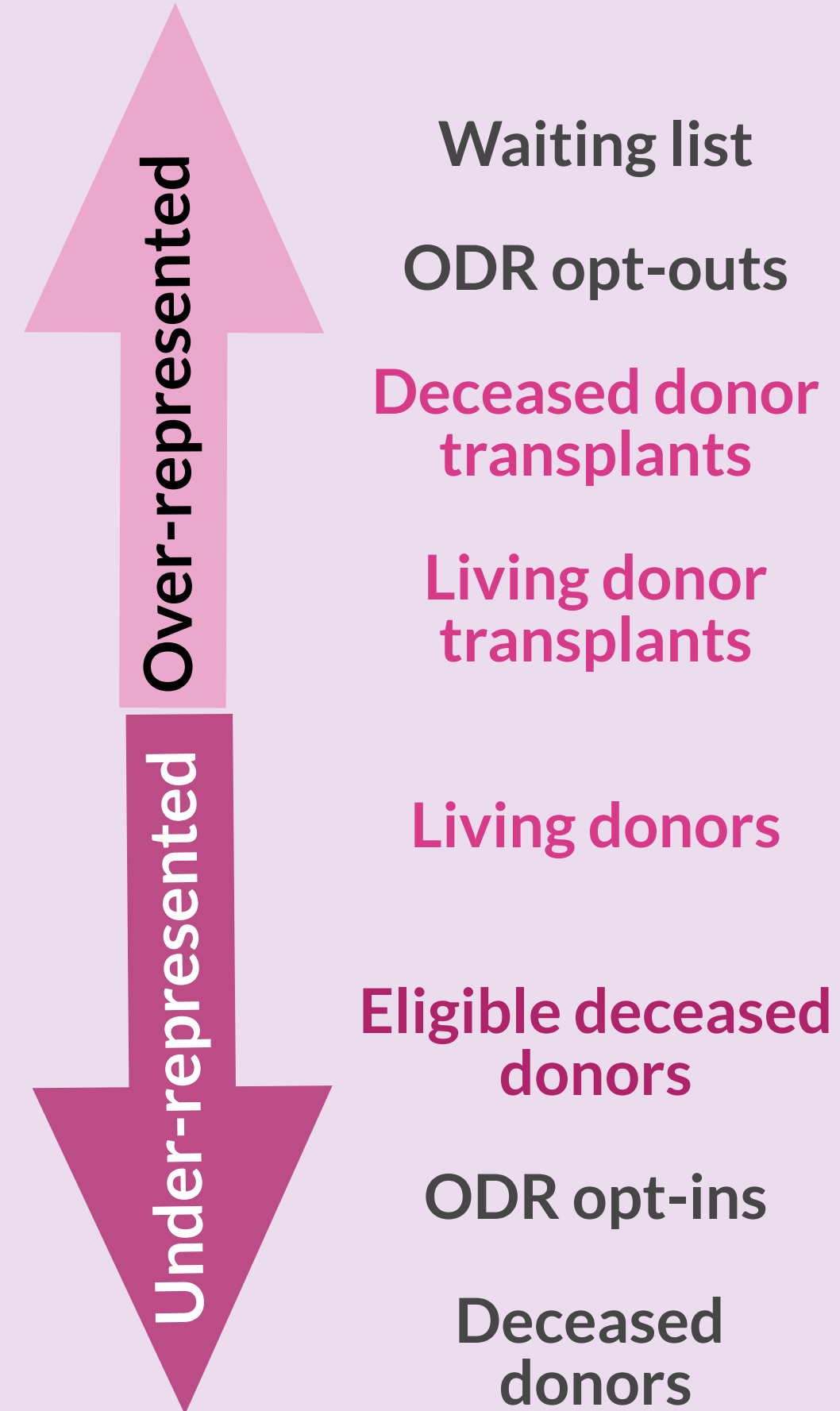
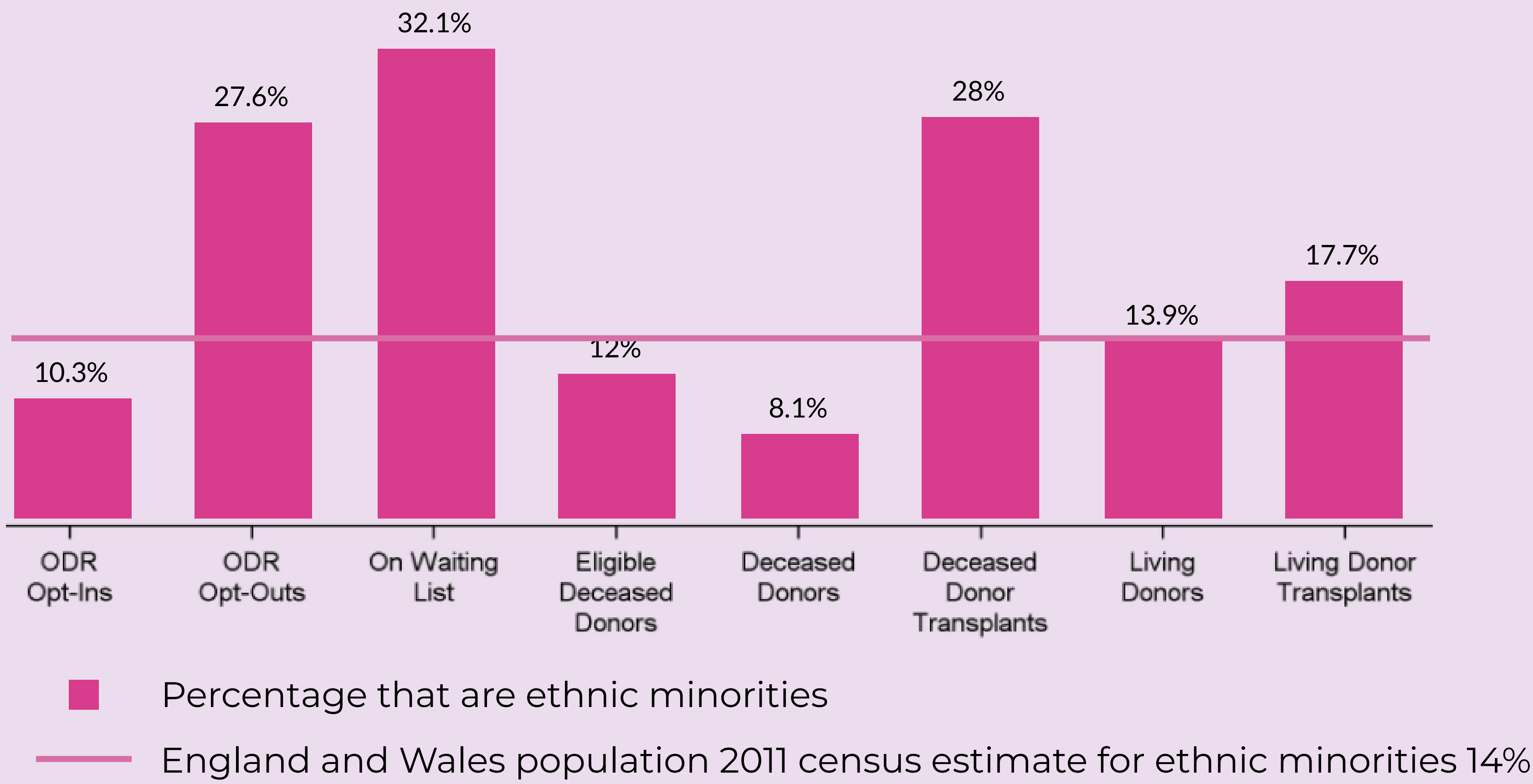


11.7% of all eligible deceased donors are from ethnic minority groups

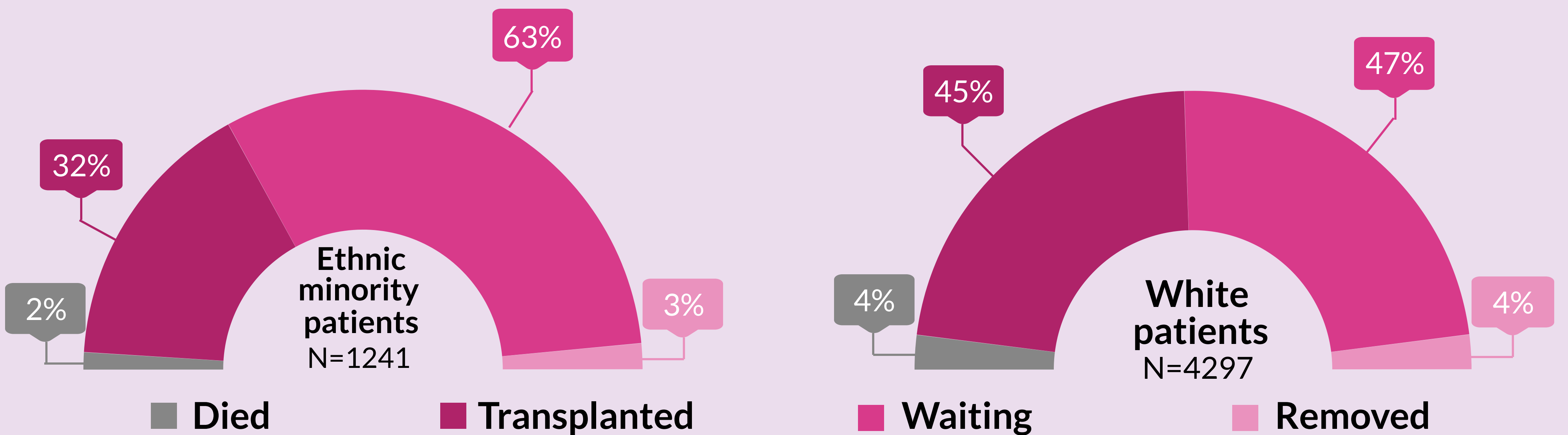


Family consent rates for organ donation are 40% for ethnic minorities and 71% for white eligible donors

Percentage that are ethnic minority relative to the population

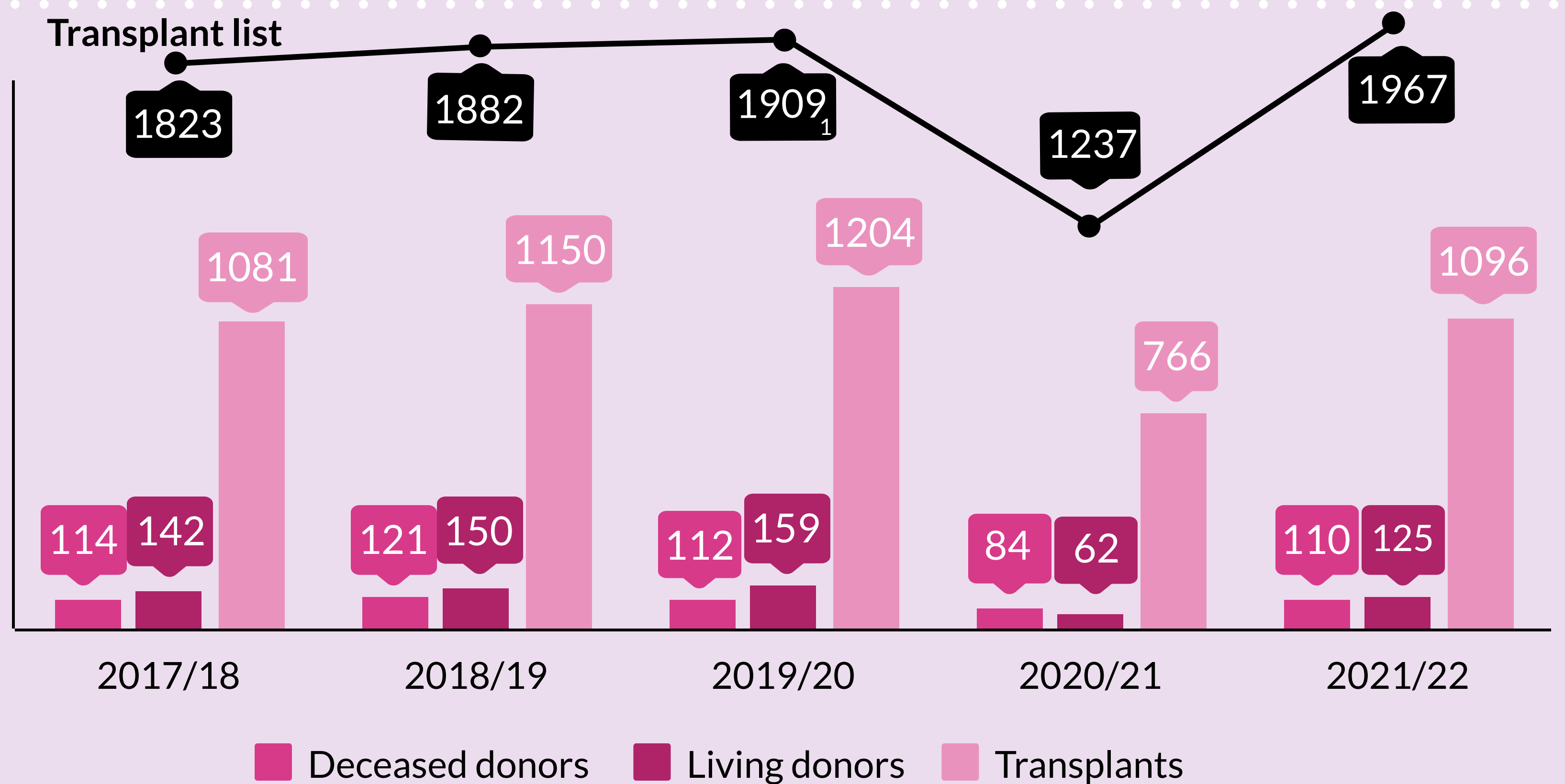


Outcome after one year of being listed for transplantation



Over the last 5 years...

- 8% increase in ethnic minority patients waiting on the list
- 1% increase in transplants for ethnic minority patients (all organs)
- 12% fall in ethnic minority living donors
- 4% fall in ethnic minority deceased organ donors
