The purpose of this report is to provide an update on progress in delivering the Sustainability Strategy 2015-2025.					
NHSBT remain committed to sustainability. We feel it is very helpful to have a short statement from the CEO setting out our commitment to sustainability, and it's also part of our approach to securing ISO certification for our approach to sustainability.					
As discussed by the Board in June, we have already met most of the commitments in the Sustainability Strategy 2020 – 2025. In the forthcoming business planning process for next year, we will set stretch targets to achieve next year. In advance of the new strategy, we are working on some actions to continue to take forward our sustainability aims, such as  - We are commissioning sustainability review for our estate so we can build carbon reduction plans for all our buildings.  - We are developing proposals for the electricity infrastructure to enable us to move towards an electrification of our fleet.  - We are working with commercial on actions we can take to support our suppliers to move towards Net Zero.  During 204/25 we will develop a sustainability strategy for the following period.
