GROUP 2 AND NON-UK RESIDENT EU GROUP 1 PATIENT TRANSPLANTS

BACKGROUND

This paper reports on a) intestinal transplants performed in Group 2 patients and b) intestinal transplants performed in Group 1 non-UK resident EU patients, between 1 February 2022 and 31 August 2022.

METHODS

Data on all Group 2 patients and all Group 1 non-UK resident EU patients who received an intestinal transplant in the UK between 1 February 2022 and 31 August 2022 were obtained from the UK Transplant Registry (UKTR) as recorded on 14 September 2022.

RESULTS

Group 1 non-UK resident EU patients

- There was one Group 1 non-UK resident EU patient intestinal transplant performed in the UK between 1 February 2022 and 31 August 2022. This was an adult patient at Cambridge who received a liver, bowel & pancreas transplant. Their permanent country of residence, as recorded on the UKTR, was Denmark and they were 21 years old at time of transplant.
- The donor was 26 years old, blood group O, with a height of 169cm and weight 60kg. There were 13 Group 1 patients on the liver and intestinal matching run, all at Cambridge. This patient ranked highest of all 13 patients on the matching run.

Group 2 patients

There were no Group 2 patient intestinal transplants performed in the UK between 1 February 2022 and 31 August 2022.
