Methodology

A face to face meeting was facilitated with stakeholders from across Wales including specialities from nursing and medical, communications and performance.

The review focused predominantly on potential donor audit data for 1st April – 31st October 2022 for all Wales. In addition some historical and national comparison data was analysed.

Data sets were provided by NHSBT. Information accessed included a detailed break down of the workforce, geography, legislation, donation activity metrics and reasons for decline. In addition an overview of public attitude and impact of regional marketing was provided.

Key time points were considered including implementation of legislation, operational changes to service and impact of global pandemic.

Data findings

It is recognised that each potential donor significantly impacts the dataset percentage. To comparatively small numbers, this can mean normal variance.

Wales has a higher proportion of opt outs. Similarly a high rate of verbal decisions not to donate has been recorded within the dataset a likely response to a longer established law. Combined this equated to 45% of reason for refusal. Adjusted consent rates were provided, removing the ODR opt out registrations from the dataset showing a >70% consent rate.

Expressed opt-outs and deemed unsupported cases account for 38% of all family approaches in Wales (compared with 27% for the UK overall)

Collaborative approach rates in Wales appear low. 13 families approached without a SNC in Wales YTD (the majority of cases it was known that the patient had opted out, therefore in Wales states probing is not appropriate)
