





How long do people wait for a heart transplant?



Days waiting (median)


Estimated time from urgent registration to transplant by centre


Registrations 1 April 2019 - 31 March 2022

National waiting time by blood group







The median is a type of average and is the time when half of patients have received a transplant



Lots of things affect how long you might wait, including your blood group, presence of antibodies and the availability of the right size organs

Nationally, 6 months after going on the non-urgent list

What are the chances of a person surviving for one year after transplant?

On average, **86 out of 100** adult patients are alive after one year following a heart transplant

One year patient survival rate
