INTRODUCTION

Dear Colleagues,

Welcome to the December UK LKD Network Newsletter.

In this edition

We look forward to welcoming you to the 2024 UK Living Kidney Donor Network Meeting which will take place on Tuesday 23rd April 2024 at the Hilton City Leeds Hotel, the same venue as last year.

The feedback from last year's meeting was very positive and we have included your suggestions in planning the content of next year's forum. The traditional opening review of living donor activity in the UK will include a focus on young donors, linking into a later session on challenging clinical scenarios in which we will also explore donor/recipient age mismatch and the assessment of donors with a previous cancer diagnosis. We also hope to look at variation in living donor transplant pathways in the UK from a sustainable healthcare perspective and explore variation in access to living donor transplantation from a socioeconomic and cultural perspective. There will also be a welcome update on Travel for Transplantation, and opportunities for networking within the planned breaks.

In this Winter Newsletter we have also included a reminder about the BTS Annual Congress in Harrogate in March 2024, and links to relevant NHSBT resources including the latest report on activity within the UK Living Kidney Sharing Scheme.

We wish you all the best for 2024 and it will be great for us all to come together for our annual Forum in April.
