FOR BLACK ETHNIC GROUPS

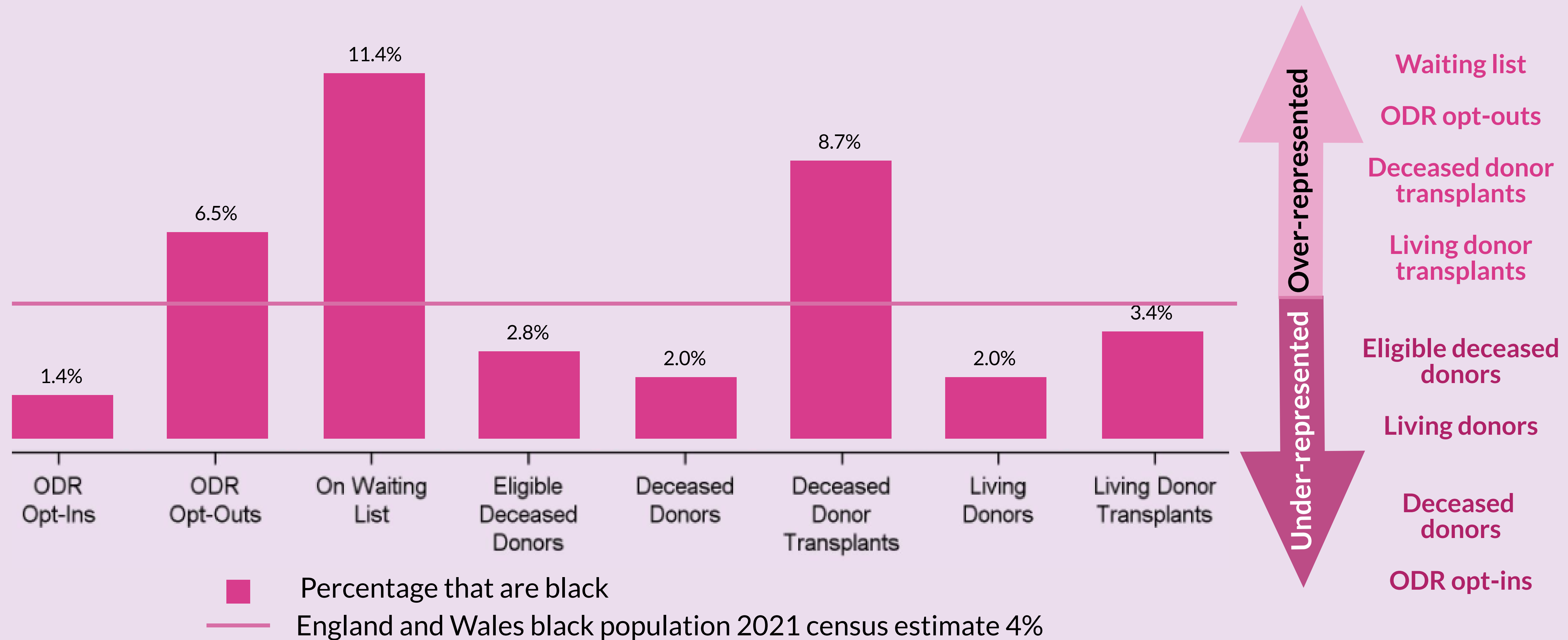
1% of people who die each year, die in circumstances suitable for organ donation

2.8% of all eligible deceased donors are black

Family consent rates for organ donation are 29.3% for black and 70% for white eligible donors

2% of all deceased donors are black

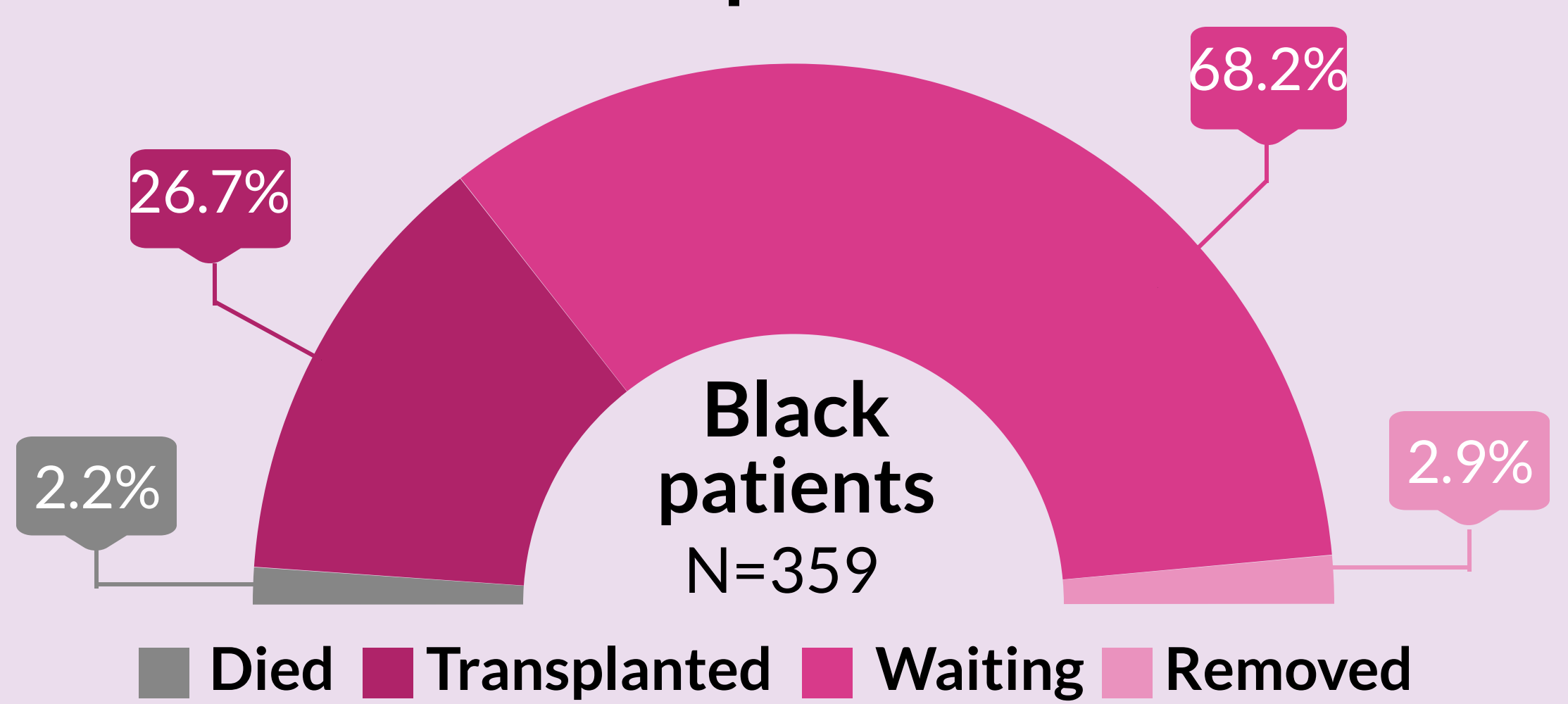

Average non-urgent transplant waiting time for black adults

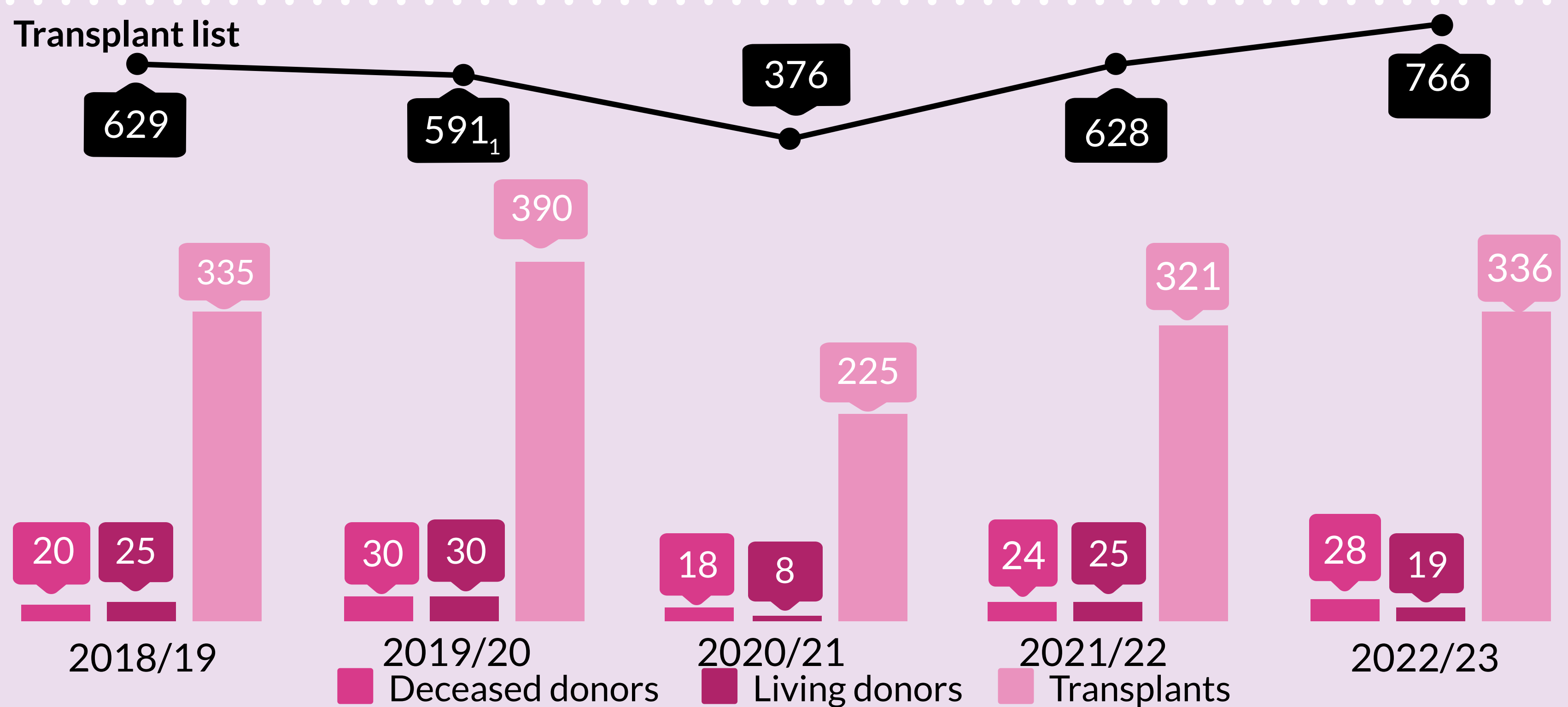


Outcome after one year of being listed for transplantation



Over the last 5 years...

- 22% increase in black patients waiting on the list
- No change in transplants for black patients
- 24% fall in black living donors
- 40% increase in black deceased organ donors
