1. Background

POL2 has been identified as a Board Policy.

POL2 has been in place as policy since 2011 and has undergone several revisions in this time to align with changes in the legal and regulatory framework, and NHSBT's organisational structure.

This revision, version 5, has been updated to reflect:

- Changes in NHSBT structure from 'Information Governance' to 'Data Security, Privacy and Records Management' (DSPR)
- Changes in the post of National Data Guardian and alignment to the role of the National Data Guardian and current Caldicott Principles
- Updates to our information sharing processes to improve security and assurance.
- Update to the explanation of penalty action according to Article 5(2) of the UK GDPR.
- Updated related documents / references.

The Board is asked to approve POL2/5 as Board Policy.
