CENTRE SPECIFIC REPORTS ON ORGAN OFFERS

- 1 A number of transplant centres request reports from NHSBT, on a routine or ad hoc basis, on the outcome of organ offers that have been received over a recent period of time. Such reports can be useful in reviewing decisions about whether or not an organ should be accepted. In particular a number of kidney transplant centres receive such reports on a regular basis.
- 2 It is proposed that regular reports of offers received should be produced and issued to all transplant centres on a routine basis for review. These reports need to be timely and it is therefore suggested that they be produced monthly. If a standard template can be agreed for bowel transplant centres, the production and issuing of reports would not be particularly difficult or time consuming.
- 3 If BAG agree this would be useful and can agree a format (suggested example on next page as a starting point for discussion), then this initiative can be introduced by the Statistics and Clinical Studies team.
