Feedback for Bowel Advisory Group (March 2013)

Members may be aware that the NHSBT Patient Consent Scheme for obtaining explicit consent for use of personal data for registration, organ allocation and transplant follow-up has been in place since 2005.

Reports are sent to Units on a monthly basis and to all Units with outstanding consent for the period dated August 2013 – February 2014. Of the 144 patients who were registered on the national list for an IFALD transplant, 100% have given consent for use of their personal data.
