

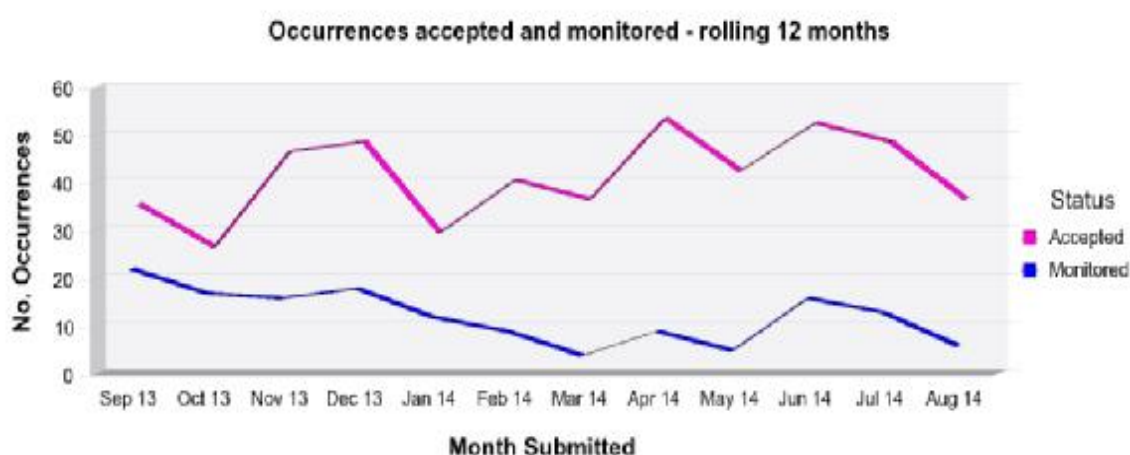

A more detailed analysis covers the first six months of the year – previous years in brackets.

There were 285 (211) incidents, but the database can only be interrogated by key words, so the figures below represent the numbers of times an organ is “mentioned”.

For context, Kidney alone is included in 55, and with other organs, 25. 19 (13) mentioned heart alone, 15 (27) mentioned heart plus other organs.

Bowel was never mentioned alone, but always with other organs, and this occurred on just 5 occasions. Specific examples will be shown at the meeting.

In contrast to the other organ types, there are no trends of concern to report to BAG.
