26/01/2011	SNOD Team: Transplant Centre:	<p>Paediatric donor incorrectly offered to a small bowel recipient, before being offered to a liver/bowel recipient. The small bowel was accepted by , the pancreas by , and liver for a small adult in .</p> <p>After discussion with the centres concerned, the decision was made by the Chair of the Bowel Advisory Group to leave things as they were and not re-offer the liver/bowel.</p> <p><u>DO action:</u> Clarification of the allocation procedure was sought within the DO; it was established that there had been a misunderstanding in the application of the allocation procedures for small bowel around the offering of small bowel and liver first prior to small bowel only. This arose partially due to the manual nature of the process. All documentation and systems were immediately amended to factor in this process.</p> <p>The incident was forwarded to ODT Clinical Governance Monitoring Group.</p>
