ACO-status not requested/granted

- General organ-allocation sequence within ET: Heart->Lung ->Liver ->Intestine->Pancreas ->Kidney.
- Lower ranked organs will follow the higher ranked organs in case of need for a combined Tx
 - For example: If the selected patient on the lung waiting list needs a combined lung-liver Tx, the liver is allocated together with the lung
- ET does not have a separate waiting list for combined organ transplantation at Eurotransplant.

ACO-Status

- „Accepted Combined Organ (ACO)-Status
 - This status can be requested for patients in need of a combined organ transplantation (excluding combinations of one non-renal organ + a kidney)
 - The request is send to external experts (auditors) of the respective Eurotransplant organ specific advisory committees for approval
 - Patients with approved ACO status are given preference in organ allocation (below “high-urgency”(HU)- but above elective patients
