

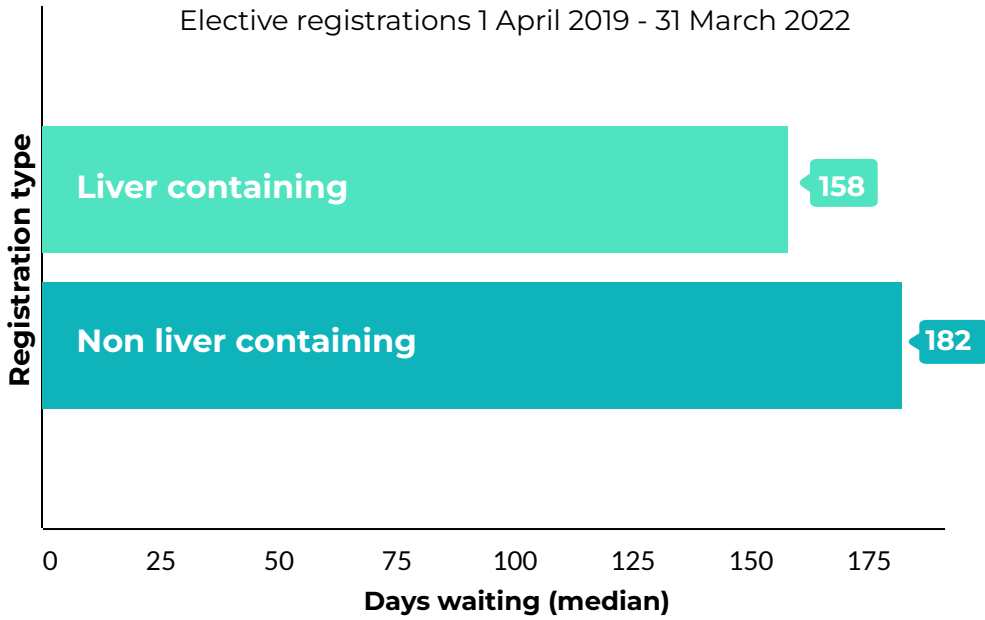


ADULT INTESTINAL TRANSPLANTS



How long do adults wait for an elective intestinal transplant?

Elective registrations 1 April 2019 - 31 March 2022

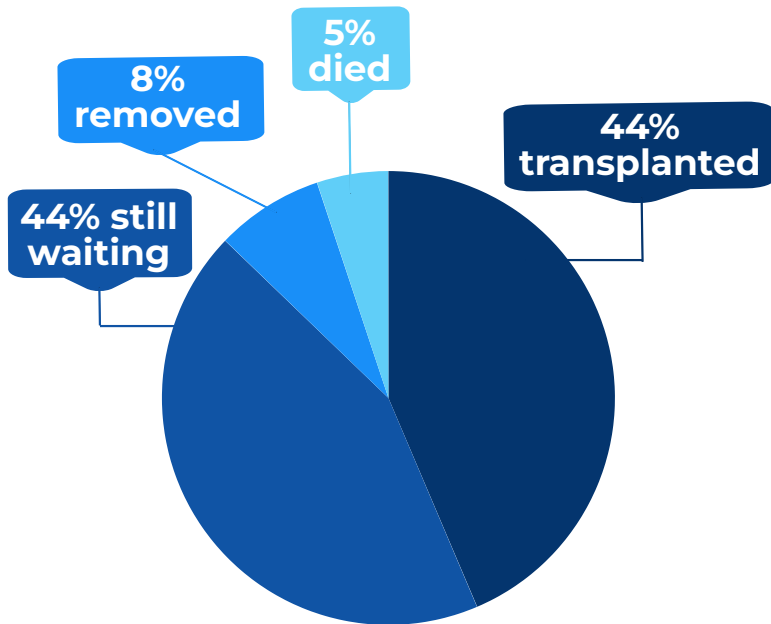


The median is a type of average and is the time when half of patients have received a transplant

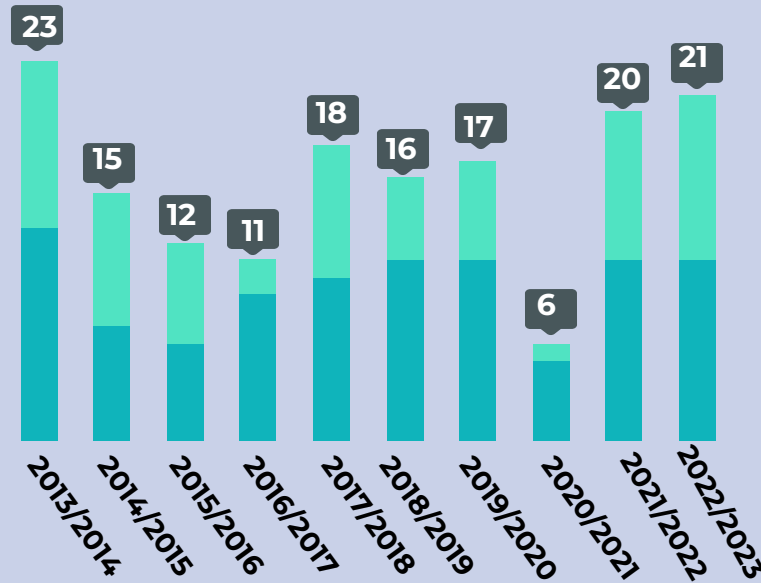
Overall median waiting time to intestine transplant for registrations between 1 April 2019 and 31 March 2022 was 175 days, or 6 months.

Lots of things affect how long you might wait, including your blood group, sensitisation and the availability of the right size organs

Nationally, 6 months after going on the elective list



Overall number of transplants per year between 1 April 2013 - 31 March 2023



What are the chances of an surviving for one year after transplant?

On average, **75 out of 100** patients are alive after one year following elective intestinal transplant where a liver was transplanted and **84 out of 100** where a liver was not transplanted

One year survival rate



What are the chances of an surviving for five years after transplant?

On average, **57 out of 100** patients are alive after five years following elective intestinal transplant where a liver was transplanted and **71 out of 100** where a liver was not transplanted

Five year survival rate
