



4. Learning from reports

Below is a summary of the findings and learning from key clinical governance reports submitted to ODT:

Date reported: 2nd May 2024 Reference:ODT-INC-7913

What was reported

A centre accepted two kidneys from different donors and patient centre lists were requested from Hub Operations, and printed out. The second pages of the lists were inadvertently mixed up, this was later identified and rectified.

Investigation findings

It was found that donor ID is recorded on the first page but not on subsequent pages.

It was requested by the transplant centre to add on donor ID on to each page of the centre patient lists to ensure clear identification.

Discussion with some of the transplant centres found that it is not unusual to print off the patient lists and they are shared with a number of clinical areas, including tissue typists, ward staff, consultants for review and identification of patients to transplant.

An IT request has been submitted to amend the reports however due to the complex IT systems this will take time for this to be put into place.
