# **Patient Safety Update**

Transplant centres have a regulatory requirement to report certain clinical incidents related to living donation and transplantation to NHSBT under their Human Tissue Authority (HTA) license and are encouraged to report all incidents to NHSBT to facilitate shared learning. The Patient Safety Team (previously Clinical Governance) has performed a thematic review of reported living donation and transplantation incidents between 2022-2024, identifying themes and trends.
