# Efficient ordering of HLA-matched platelets to support timely patient care

To avoid delays when you submit a request, please note the following:

- If you know the patient has received HLA selected platelets previously, please select 'Order for known patient'
- If you're unsure if the patient has received HLA selected platelets previously, please telephone the H&I platelet desk on 0208 957 2814 to check
- If you're unable to telephone due to time pressures, then submit as a known patient. This will either expedite processing or prompt H&I to contact the hospital for further information

Using the correct request (either a first-time order or order for a known patient) helps speed up issue times and prevents delays to patient care.

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NHS England sickle cell and thalassaemia blood group genotyping test - patient referral and programme extension. Testing remains free of charge until 30 June 2025

## Blood group genotyping programme

The NHS England Sickle Cell and Thalassaemia blood group genotyping programme will continue to provide free-of-charge testing to hospitals until 30 June 2025.

## **Programme extension**

We are working closely with NHS England to secure additional funding to support testing beyond June 2025. We will update you as soon as we can.

# Monthly sample and referral data

If you would like a list of patients whose samples have been received, accepted or rejected from your hospital, please email Transfusion@nhsbt.nhs.uk providing the hospital(s) name and the email address of a named Consultant, or clinical lead.

#### Rejection reports

We are processing samples and referrals as soon we receive them and making the rejection reports available on <u>Sp-ICE</u>.

#### **Genotyping results reporting**

Our teams are working to issue results as soon as possible. We will notify the relevant teams in hospitals before issuing genotyping reports.

#### Please support the clinical audit of RCI on-call referrals starting 1 June 2025

As we are experiencing an increasing number of on-call referrals we're undertaking a national re-audit (the last one was in 2017) of on-call activity, to provide insight into the significant developments in our workload: since 2017 there has been a 31% increase.

The objectives of the audit are to assess:

• the characteristics of referrals to RCI laboratories outside of core hours

• the proportion of units that were cross-matched on-call, which were transfused during, or within three hours of, the out-of-hours period

RCI staff conducting the audit may be in touch to collect supporting data and we would be grateful if you would help.

The audit period may vary between RCI laboratories in line with activity levels, but we anticipate data collection will be completed by the end of September 2025.
