To ensure that this remains accessible to all who have supported their loved ones in becoming an organ donor, Trentham will allow free access to the Gardens for NHSBT gold pin badge holders, subject to conditions outlined opposite.

Opening hours vary depending upon the season – please check on our website for the latest opening times prior to setting out on your journey.

Terms and Conditions

- Free entry to the gardens applies only to individual gold pin badge holders, and not to companions or groups.
- Free entry can only be granted on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays after 9am.
- You must collect tickets upon arrival from the main garden entrance, after which entry for NHSBT badge holders will be via the North entrance only.
- There are certain times during the year when access is restricted for members only, and sadly during these times free NHSBT badge holder access cannot be granted.
- There are also occasional weeks in the year when access may be granted throughout the entire week, however these dates are dependent upon events already being held at the gardens.
