### Acceptable Usage Terms and Conditions

Before you are authorised to access ODT systems, you must read these Terms and Conditions and sign the form on page 3 to indicate that you abide by them. You should also retain them for future reference.

You must comply with all data security protocols outlined in your organisations Memorandum of Understanding/Material Transfer Agreement with NHSBT including never allowing another to use your account.

#### The Service

TransplantPath is a service provided by NHS Blood and Transplant (NHSBT) for authorised NHS transplant colleagues in UK Hospitals, National Transplant Centres, National Tissue Centres, and Approved Research Institutions. The service supports the assessment of organ and tissue donor suitability.

TransplantPath is a secure web application accessible from any internet enabled device. It provides a real-time view of donor information entered by Specialist Nurses and, where permitted by user role, allows authorised users to add, edit, or update specific data fields. All data entry and modification must be carried out in accordance with NHSBT policies, clinical governance requirements, and applicable data protection legislation.

#### Terms of Use

Access to the service is restricted to employees of organisations that have a current data sharing Memorandum of Understanding/Material Transfer Agreement with NHSBT.

All users must complete all mandatory training and only access the system for legitimate clinical or operational purposes related to their role.

Users with permissions to add or edit data are responsible for ensuring that all information entered is accurate, complete, timely, and lawful. Users must not knowingly enter false, misleading, or inappropriate information and must only modify data within the scope of their professional responsibilities.

NHSBT reserves the right to modify or revoke user permissions at any time to maintain system integrity, patient safety, and compliance with regulatory requirements.

#### Accessing the Service

TransplantPath credentials are managed via Azure AD and the Admin Portal can only be accessed via the NHSBT Private Network.

TransplantPath users must have an Azure AD account belonging to a trust or Academic site that NHSBT has granted access to. Private accounts are prohibited. TransplantPath authenticates users using Azure SSO, their own NHS trust policies for user account, password management and 2 Factor Authentication (2FA) apply. Additionally, NHSBT enforces its own 2FA via Azure AD. Each individual user will also need to be granted access to TransplantPath via the Admin Portal, where their user role can be applied.

#### The Data

All data processed within TransplantPath is handled in accordance with Data Protection legislation and Caldicott principles.

Data processing is compliant with GDPR Articles 6 1e, 6 1a, 9 2h, and 9 2a.

Users who create or modify data must ensure that all entries comply with NHSBT data standards, clinical documentation requirements, and relevant regulatory frameworks. Any errors identified must be reported immediately to NHSBT.

## Consent

By agreeing to these Terms and Conditions you consent to NHSBT recording in an audit log your activity in the service. The audit log will record your usernames, timestamps, and details of all actions performed, including data creation, modification, and deletion.

Audit data is required to optimise the delivery of the service and to act as a medical / legal record to be able to support any investigations.

You agree to upholding all principles of Data Protection Legislation especially as it relates to PID. The supplied data may only be reviewed by the intended recipient and must not be shared with any other parties.

You confirm that you have received appropriate data security and protection training in the last 12 months and are aware of the confidential nature and duties placed on those processing identifiable, sensitive, confidential, and anonymised/pseudonymised information.

If you become aware of any unlawful accessing of the service, then you must notify NHSBT Service Desk on [service.desk@nhsbt.nhs.uk](mailto:service.desk@nhsbt.nhs.uk) within 24 hours.

If you leave your role you must ensure your account is closed by notifying your local organisation who will revoke your access to your Azure AD account.

Your TransplantPath access will be deactivated after 12 months on non-usage. If you still require access after this time, please reapply as outlined in 'Accessing the Service' above.
