ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE NATIONAL PANCREAS OFFERING SCHEME

**6 YEARS OF ACTIVITY -
11 SEPTEMBER 2019 TO 10 SEPTEMBER 2025**

INTRODUCTION

1. The National Pancreas Offering Scheme was revised on 11 September 2019 to introduce a new top tier for patients. A review of the first year was presented at PAG in November 2020. The second 6 months of the scheme were severely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and the scheme activity has not yet returned to pre-COVID levels.
2. Between March and August 2020, pancreas transplantation was suspended for a period of time and as centres began reopening with selected patients, it was agreed to have a deviation from the offering scheme. Tier A patients were still given patient specific offers but organs were then fast tracked to centres for use in any of their listed patients. The deviation came to an end on 10 August 2020, when five centres were re-opened.
3. This paper summarises activity in the first 6 years of the scheme.

(CIT reported on pancreas transplant record form)

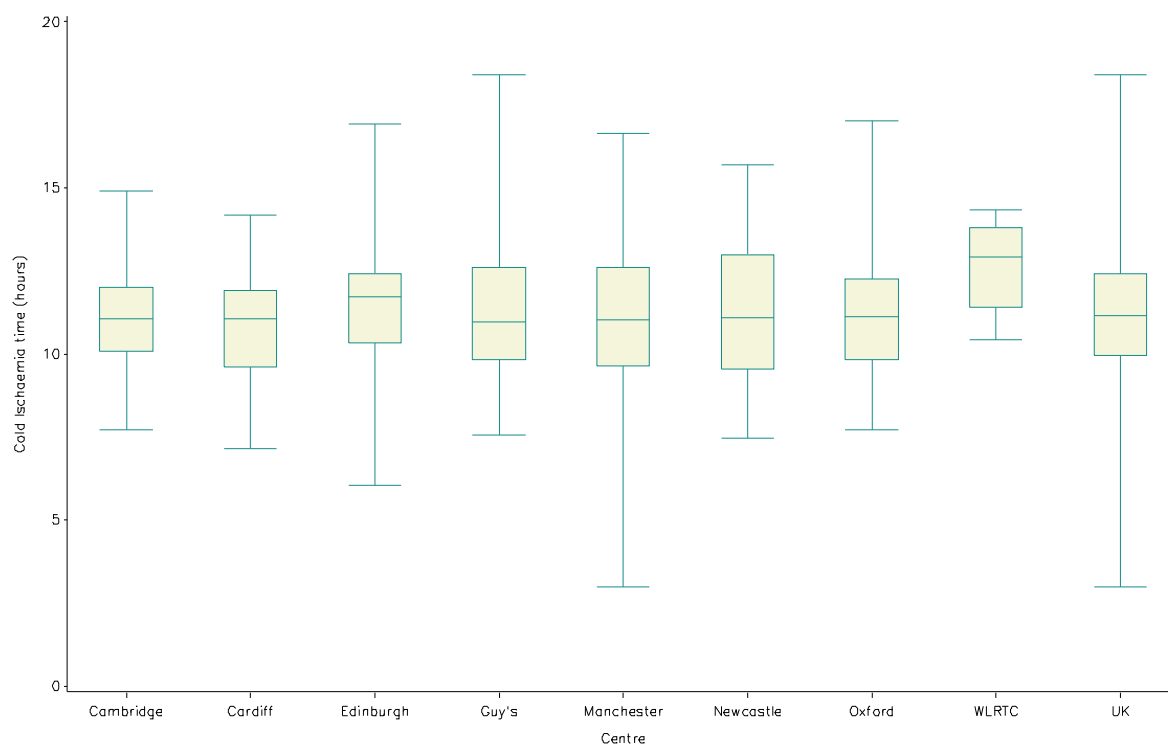
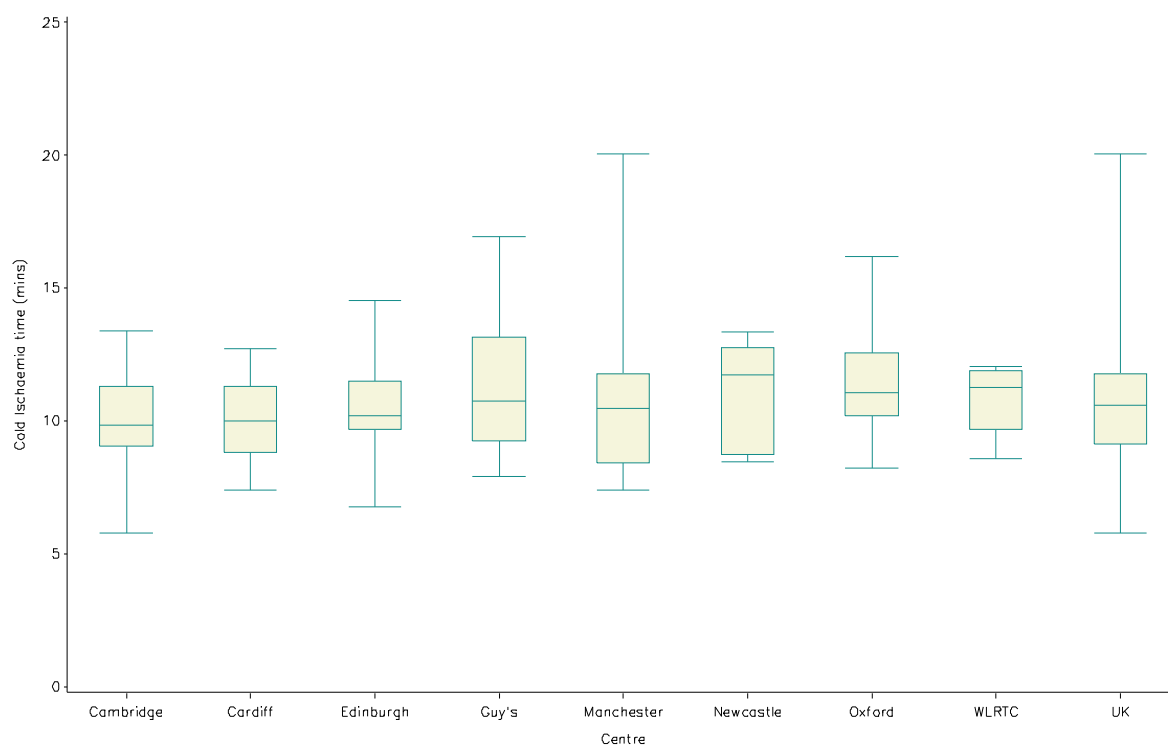


Figure 1.9 Centre-specific cold ischaemia time - vascularised pancreas (DCD)
