- 7 There has been a lot of work involved in some of the papers brought to this PAG meeting.
- 8 We are waiting for various database changes to be made, but due to resource reallocated to digital offering and SCORE programmes, there will be a long wait for these changes.
- 9 We have done work on validating the US Pancreas Donor Risk Index (PDRI) on UK data with a view to creating a UK PDRI and will continue with this work soon.
- 10 A journal paper is being prepared on DCD islet isolation and transplantation.
- 11 We are involved in the work to upgrade the database where pancreas and islet data reside, as well as making some agreed changes to some data collection forms.
