

Retrieval Governance Report NRG 29th March 2017

There were 75 incidents out of 497 retrievals reported to the governance team between 1st November 2016 and 23rd March 2017.

- Organ Losses: 13
 - Liver: 1 retrieval and trauma injuries
 - Kidneys 9: Vascular Damage, Poor Perfusion, Intimal Dissection, Rewarming Injury (INC 2199),
 - Pancreas 3: No Iliac Vessels, damage
- Organ Damage not resulting in organ loss: 15
 - Liver 5
 - Kidney 5
 - Pancreas 3
 - Heart Valve 2
- Organ Quality: 7
 - Kidney 3
 - Pancreas Islets 3
 - Lungs 1
- Biopsy: INC 2126 (Neuroendocrine tumor SB)
- Mobilization/Delays: INC 2139, INC 2162, INC 2197

Points for discussion

- Review of Performance of a NORS Abdominal Team.
 - The review was conducted on all activity and has not shown any specific worrying pattern.
 - The Organ damage rate was similar to the rate of other centers as well as the organ utilization rates.
- Islet Cell Incidents: INC 2112, 2113, 2115
 - Defining Organ damage for Pancreases retrieved for Islets.
- Splitting of Liver:
 - INC 2107; Delay on organ acceptance (Kidneys) impacted on the Liver leaving donor theatre.
 - INC 2284; Prolonged CIT to Liver due to decision/assessment for splitting

Conclusion

Organ damage leading to organ loss represented 2.6% of all retrieval performed; it is identical to last reports in November and June 2016.

The CRM round will start Friday 31st March.

Organ Damage validation process has been implemented as agreed at last NRG.

A proposal on CUSUM signal for NORS Teams will be presented at next NRG.
